Dear Parishioners,

- ◆ Pentecost Sunday celebrates the birthday of the church. The Holy Spirit, the third person of the Blessed Trinity, gave birth to the church. The Nicene Creed proclaims I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of life, who proceeds from the father and the son, with the father and the son he is worshipped and glorified. The twelve disciples and the blessed mother were in the Upper Room, hiding behind closed doors. Suddenly, a strong driving wind rushed forth into the room. And the rest is history. The Holy Spirit is “*Ruah*”, the breath, air, communion, life and love.
- ◆ Pentecost is the beginning of the church, “*Ekklesia*” (*to call out*) the Greek translation or rendering of the word church with its Hebrew counterpart “*Qahal*” (*assembly of the people*). The church is feminine in nature. She’s like the beautiful bride, or the affectionate mother who constantly nurtures her children in faith. The church is not predominantly about structure, action, theory and rules to follow but essentially, receptive to the people. The church is a divinely established theological reality. She is not a product of human invention, ingenuity, progress and discovery. The church is communion with God and with one another, that is, fellow believers.
- ◆ We often hear this term, apostolic foundation. Christ chose the twelve apostles and gave them power and authority. The twelve represents the restoration/unification of the twelve tribes that formed the people of God. Apostle means “one who is sent” which signifies the missionary character of the church. To be an apostle is to be a witness to the resurrection who mission is to carry out the message of Christ ‘to the ends of the earth’ (Acts 1: 8), to go out to all the nations and make all men his disciples (Mt. 28: 19). The mission is universal and not only limited to one nation.
- ◆ This weekend is also a special time to reflect on the status of the Catholic community. Is our church timid, tired, bored, closed, frozen, too cautious, self-referential, anti-social, exclusive, fearful church as illustrated in the Upper Room prior to Pentecost? Or bold, energetic, tireless, open, mission-driven, selfless, out into the world, inclusive, fearless, unafraid, evangelizers and proclaimers of the gospel and its message?
- ◆ I fervently pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to ignite, light a fire, and put a spark in our communities. With open hearts, let us welcome the outpouring of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit in holy abundance (Piety, Fear of the Lord, Knowledge, Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel and Fortitude).

Estimados feligreses,

- ♦ El domingo de Pentecostés celebra el cumpleaños de la iglesia. El Espíritu Santo, la tercera persona de la Santísima Trinidad, dio origen a la iglesia. El Credo Niceno proclama que creo en el Espíritu Santo, el Señor y dador de vida, que procede del padre y del hijo, con el padre y el hijo es adorado y glorificado. Los doce discípulos y la bendita Madre estaban en el Aposento, escondidos tras puertas cerradas. De repente, un viento fuerte y afuerazo entró en la sala. Y el resto es historia. El Espíritu Santo es "*Ruah*", el aliento, el aire, la comunión, la vida y el amor.
- ♦ Pentecostés es el comienzo de la iglesia, "Ekklesia" (*llamar*) la traducción o traducción griega de la palabra iglesia con su contraparte hebrea "Qahal" (*asamblea del pueblo*). La iglesia es de naturaleza femenina. Es como la hermosa novia, o la madre cariñosa que constantemente cuida a sus hijos con fe. La iglesia no se basa principalmente en la estructura, la acción, la teoría y las reglas que seguir, sino esencialmente receptiva a la gente. La iglesia es una realidad teológica divinamente establecida. No es producto de la invención, la ingeniosidad, el progreso y el descubrimiento humanos. La iglesia es comunión con Dios y entre nosotros, es decir, con los creyentes.
- ♦ A menudo oímos este término, fundación apostólica. Cristo eligió a los doce apóstoles y les dio poder y autoridad. Los doce representan la restauración/unificación de las doce tribus que formaron el pueblo de Dios. Apóstol significa "el que ha sido enviado", lo que simboliza el carácter misionero de la iglesia. Ser apóstol es ser testigo de la resurrección cuya misión es llevar a cabo el mensaje de Cristo 'hasta los confines de la tierra' (Hechos 1:8), salir a todas las naciones y hacer de todos los hombres sus discípulos (Mt. 28:19). La misión es universal y no limitada solo a una nación.
- ♦ Este fin de semana también es un momento especial para reflexionar sobre el estado de la comunidad católica. ¿Es nuestra iglesia tímida, cansada, aburrida, cerrada, congelada, demasiado cautelosa, autorreferencial, antisocial, exclusiva y temerosa, como se ilustra en el Cenáculo antes de Pentecostés? ¿O audaces, enérgicos, incansables, abiertos, impulsados por la misión, desinteresados, que salen al mundo, sean inclusivos, valientes, sin miedo, evangelizadores y proclamadores del evangelio y su mensaje?
- ♦ Rezo fervientemente para que el Espíritu Santo siga encendiendo, encendiendo un fuego y encendiendo la chispa en nuestras comunidades. Con el corazón abierto, acojamos la derramación de los siete dones del Espíritu Santo en abundancia santa (Piedad, Temor al Señor, Conocimiento, Sabiduría, Entendimiento, Consejo y Fortaleza).
