

Dear Parishioners,

- ◆ Happy Independence Day! Happy 4th of July! Even if it's past July 4th, I hope it's not too late to greet all of you as America commemorated its 249th birthday. I'm sure everyone enjoyed the parade, barbeques and fireworks on Friday and joined in unison the lyrics of this deeply moving song, God bless America. Land that I love. Stand beside her and guide her through the night with a light from above. America is a religious country by the way she invokes the holy name of God in civil occasions. A country whose motto is, In God we trust and strongly promotes, One Nation Under God. She believes that All men are created and born equal. A country promotes the enjoyment of life, liberty and property and the pursuit of happiness and common sense, too.
- ◆ After all the grandiose celebration of special feasts the past few weeks, we now turn and continue our journey to the gospel of Luke which begins with the long series of instructions on how to carry out the mission. By virtue of baptism, believe it or not, we are all engaged in evangelization and the best way possible is, not to say evangelize at all. Our lives speak volumes of the God we believe, the faith we profess and the manner we treat our neighbors and the rest of humanity. It is said that if we want to make disciples or draw people to the Lord, we must become disciples ourselves first which starts with our own human limitations and belief that anything is possible with God.
- ◆ In this text, Jesus wanted to make sure that before any follower embark on the work of evangelization, there must be training and formation involved. We will try as best we can to relate these difficult instructions in the context of life here in southern Arizona. In other words, the rules of engagement.
- ◆ First, Jesus sends us **Like Lambs among wolves** (10: 3). We are not wolves among Lambs. Jesus said that one day wolves and lambs would and should live together in peaceful co-existence despite their differences. The wolf and lamb will enjoy hospitality and will share the same accommodation. As prophet Isaiah mentioned, the leopard will lie down with the kid. This is not totally impossible though as many of us have seen a preview of this that both wolves and lambs will serve each other like slaves. None of them will assert power or desire to be greater than the other. Between lambs and wolves will be a sibling community whose vulnerability will melt the hearts of the loud and proud.
- ◆ **Greeting no one along the way** (10: 4) doesn't mean ignoring everyone or refraining from saying hi and hello. We are urged to focus on the mission and not to be distracted momentarily by unnecessary events. We are asked to wait and if you can't wait, the first greeting must always be peace (shalom).
- ◆ **When you enter a house or Into whatever house you enter** (10: 5-12), first say, **peace**. If your words are not well received. No worries, your peace won't be a waste. The blessing of peace will return to you. Disciples are reminded not to defend themselves against attackers. They must exercise and allow themselves even to be struck in the face (hope this is metaphorical) and be prepared to be driven out of places that don't accept you and refuse to receive you.

Incluso si es más allá del 4 de julio, espero que no sea demasiado tarde para saludarlos a todos ustedes mientras Estados Unidos conmemora su cumpleaños número 249. Estoy seguro de que todos disfrutaron del desfile, las barbacoas y los fuegos artificiales el viernes y se unieron al unísono a la letra de esta canción profundamente conmovedora, Dios bendiga a Estados Unidos. Tierra que amo. Párate a su lado y guíala a través de la noche con una luz desde arriba. Estados Unidos es un país religioso por la forma en que invoca el santo nombre de Dios en ocasiones civiles. Un país cuyo lema es, En Dios confiamos y promueve con firmeza, Una Nación Bajo Dios. Ella cree que todos los hombres son creados y nacen iguales. Nuestras vidas hablan mucho del Dios en el que creemos, de la fe que profesamos y de la manera en que tratamos a nuestro prójimo y al resto de la humanidad. Se dice que si queremos hacer discípulos o atraer a las personas al Señor, primero debemos convertirnos en discípulos, lo que comienza con nuestras propias limitaciones humanas y nuestra creencia de que todo es posible con Dios.
- ♦ En este texto, Jesús quería asegurarse de que antes de que cualquier seguidor se embarque en la obra de evangelización, debe haber entrenamiento y formación involucrados. - ♦ Primero, Jesús nos envía **como corderos entre lobos** (10:3). No somos lobos entre corderos. 


