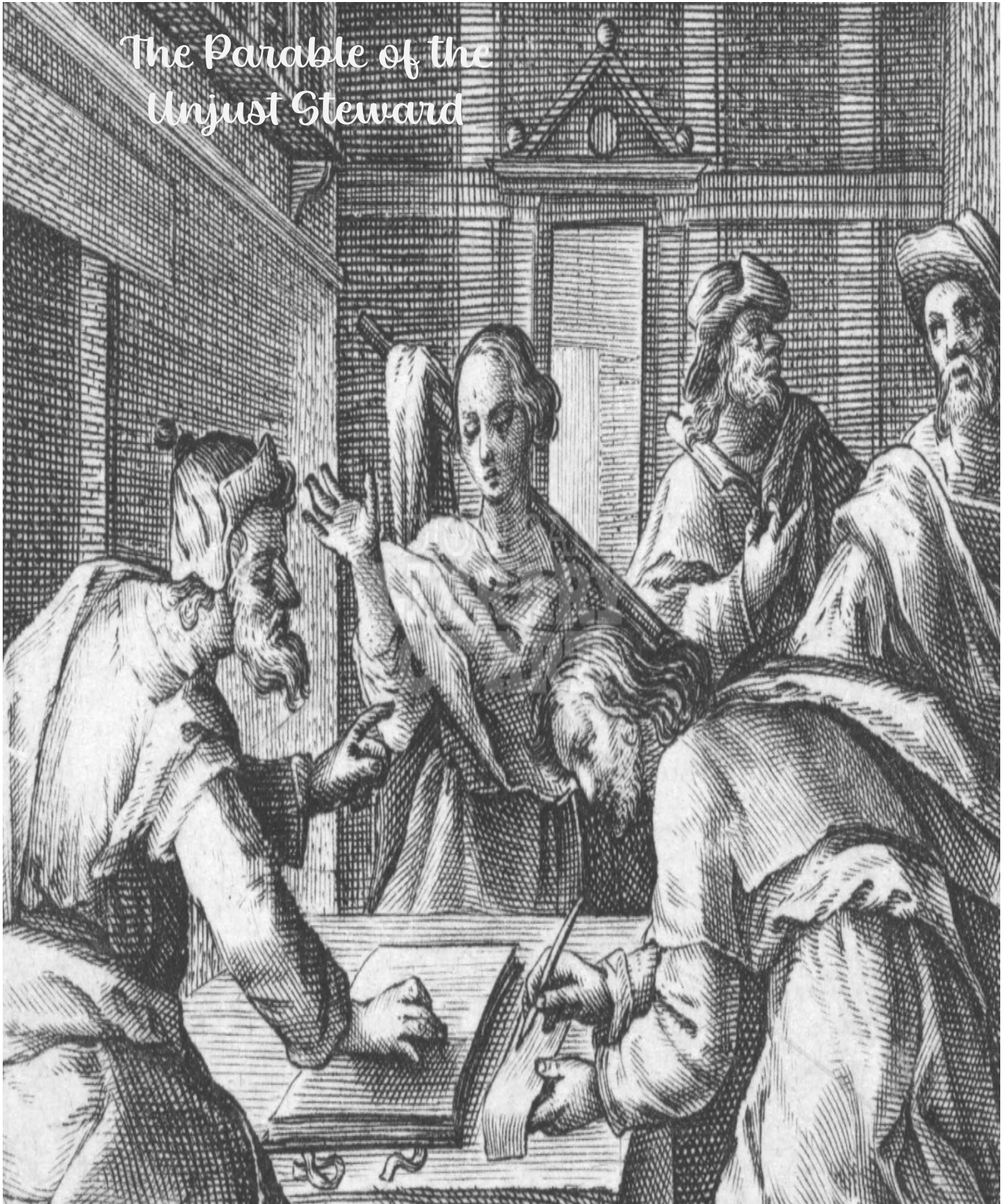

Dear Parishioners,

- ♦ This Sunday is Catechetical Sunday with the theme, “Always be ready to give an explanation (for a reason) for your hope (1 Peter 3: 15).” This theme is so timely as we are solemnly observing the Jubilee Year of Hope, one of the theological virtues. The Lord provides hope. St. Peter urges us to be prepared to articulate the basis/foundation of our faith, with respect and gentleness. Catholicism is a reasoned faith. We can use reason to explain our faith. That’s why, it is necessary to study our faith in our classroom and not only as an ordinary classroom but as a sacramental space and sacred environment where we penetrate the depths of life. The desire, the seeking and search for wholeness and fulfillment in life is, as it were, a hunger and thirst for God and that’s religion. There will be a blessing/commissioning of Catechists in the Sunday Masses.
- ♦ This Sunday’s gospel, the parable of the dishonest steward, is one of the strangest passages and by far, the most difficult to interpret. No wonder, there have been so many commentaries about the narrative. With his back against the wall, he immediately figured out a way to get out of trouble by negotiating (removing) the interest. If he didn’t act on it rapidly, the boss would have fired him instantly. But it appeared he didn’t want to dismiss him. Remember the power of second chances. At the end of the episode, Jesus commended the clever steward for his astuteness in rectifying a would have been shameful scenario and terrible crisis. It could have easily gone out of proportion had he not acted on it. Jesus praised him despite the mess he created because of how he handled a difficult issue and straightened things out. He made everyone involved happy, satisfied and delighted and in fact, still made friends. All winners and no losers. Grace, healing and mercy can still work in a seemingly hopeless and ugly situation.
- ♦ Thank you to those who graced the St. Luke Parish Fiesta with their presence. The support this year was phenomenal and extraordinary in ways I cannot put in words. We may not meet our monetary goal, but we will always cherish the memories of this year’s festival. Thank you to the fiesta committee who made this parish event special and to the volunteers for their hard work. Even if the weather was not on our side, still we managed to enjoy the moment and whatever St. Luke had to offer. Thank you to all who helped prepare the super food, the volunteers who set up and taken down the tents, manned the booths, provided music and entertainment, fun and games.

Please support Loretto School, a jewel in the crown, and a Catholic school that lives up to its name: educating for life in the mind and heart of Christ. Happy 101-year-old Loretto School. Queridos Feligreses,

- ◆ Este domingo es el domingo catequético con el tema: "Estén siempre listos para dar una explicación (por una razón) de su esperanza (1 Pedro 3: 15)". Este tema es tan actual cuando celebramos solemnemente el Año jubilar de la esperanza, una de las virtudes teologales. El Señor proporciona esperanza. San Pedro nos insta a estar preparados para articular la base / fundamento de nuestra fe, con respeto y gentileza. El catolicismo es una fe razonada. Podemos usar la razón para explicar nuestra fe. Por eso, es necesario estudiar nuestra fe en nuestro aula y no solo como un aula ordinaria sino como un espacio sacramental y un ambiente sagrado donde penetramos en las profundidades de la vida. El deseo, la búsqueda y la búsqueda de plenitud y plenitud en la vida es, por así decirlo, hambre y sed de Dios y eso es religión. Habrá una bendición / comisión de catequistas en las misas dominicales.
- ◆ El evangelio de este domingo, la parábola del mayordomo deshonesto, es uno de los pasajes más extraños y, con mucho, el más difícil de interpretar. No es de extrañar que haya habido tantos comentarios sobre la narrativa. Con la espalda contra la pared, inmediatamente descubrió una manera de salir del problema negociando (eliminando) el interés. Si no hubiera actuado rápidamente, el jefe lo habría despedido instantáneamente. Pero parecía que no quería despedirlo. Recuerda el poder de las segundas oportunidades. Al final del episodio, Jesús elogió al inteligente mayordomo por su astucia al rectificar un escenario vergonzoso y una crisis terrible. Fácilmente podría haber sido desproporcionado si no hubiera actuado en consecuencia. Jesús lo elogió a pesar del desastre que creó debido a la forma en que manejó un problema difícil y enderezó las cosas. Hizo que todos los involucrados estuvieran felices, satisfechos y encantados y, de hecho, todavía hizo amigos. Todos ganadores y ningún perdedor. La gracia, la sanidad y la misericordia aún pueden funcionar en una situación aparentemente desesperada y fea.
- ◆ Gracias a aquellos que honraron la Fiesta de la Parroquia de San Lucas con su presencia. El apoyo de este año fue fenomenal y extraordinario de una manera que no puedo expresar con palabras. Puede que no cumplamos con nuestra meta monetaria, pero siempre apreciaremos los recuerdos del festival de este año. 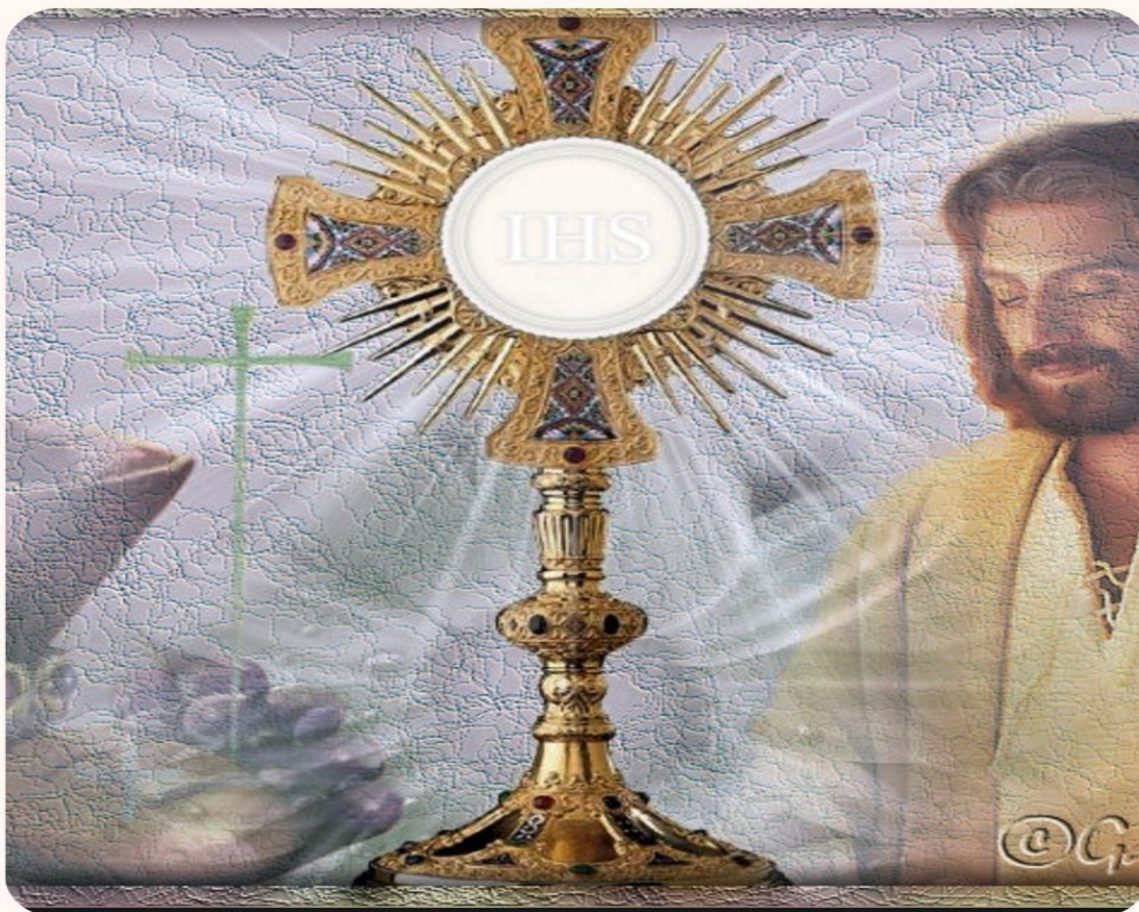

The classes are conducted Mondays, and begin Sept. 29, 2025, 7—8:30 pm, parish hall at St. Luke.

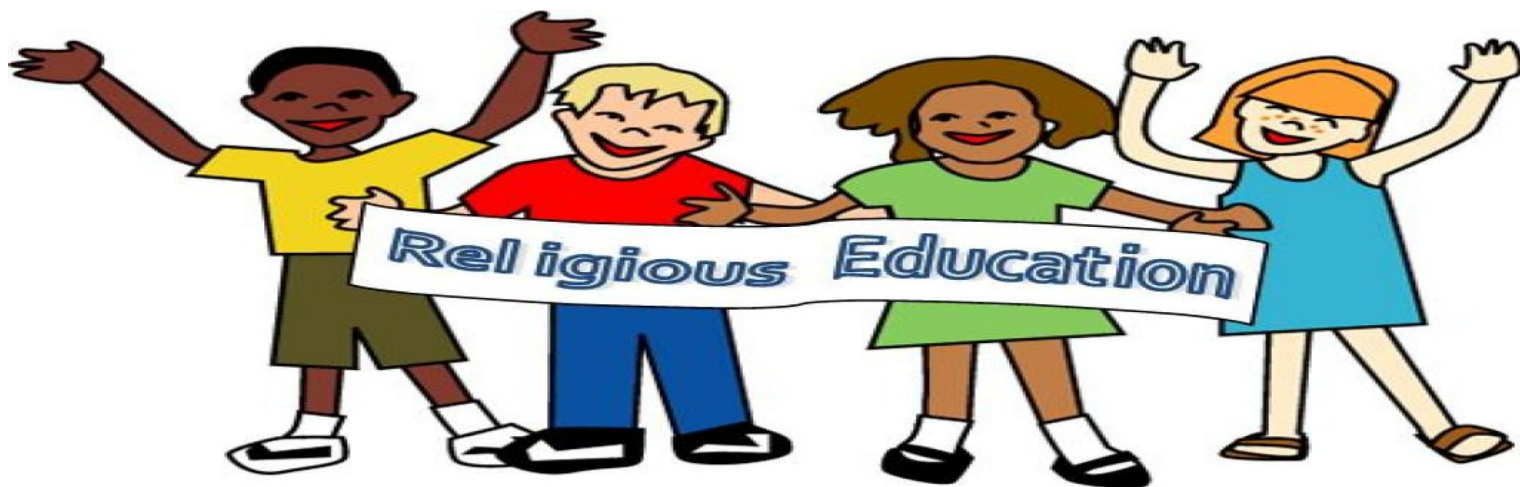
SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

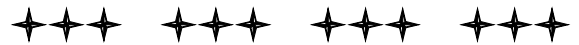

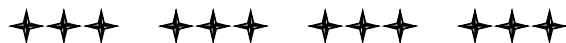

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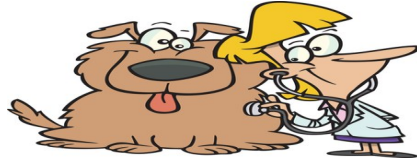
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
