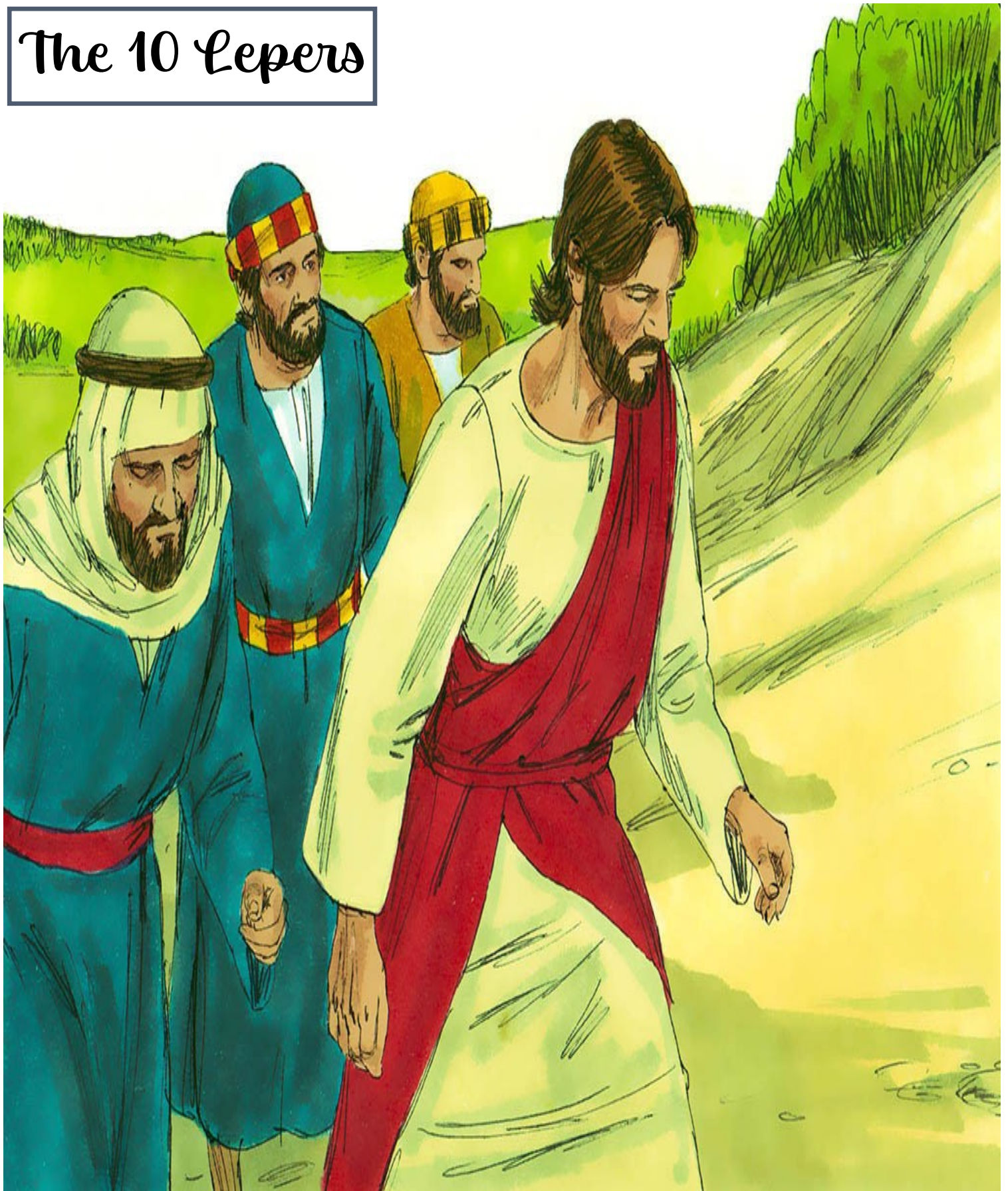

Dear Parishioners,

- ♦ Thank you to all the volunteers of the Immaculate Conception Parish Fiesta del Sol for a job well done. There was great participation not only from parishioners but all over the town and beyond. The crowd was electric, the food so delicious and the music a huge delight. The entertainment provided by the entertainers (singers, band members and dancers) was fabulous. I believe the throngs of people who graced the festival with their presence had so much fun and relaxation, which was exactly what we needed after a day's work. Thank you for supporting the fiesta and for spending your money for the household of God. Thank you to the fiesta committee for all the hard work and collaboration. It is a concerted effort for the glory of God. As always, the Mass was the highlight of the event.
- ♦ In the story of the cleansing of the Ten Lepers, this Sunday's theme highlights gratitude in the saving and healing power of God. Giving thanks to God is paramount. Recognizing our blessings is a sign of faith. Jesus replied, *"Ten were cleansed, were they not? Where are the other nine? Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?"* The leper didn't go anywhere but first knelt before the feet of Jesus in gratitude. He recognized the goodness and healing power of God. How come only one leper returned to give thanks and this fellow was a foreigner (*allegenes*, an alien/outsider that is, someone who doesn't really belong)? The healed foreigner found a home in the presence of God in Christ. In the first reading, Naaman, an army commander was healed of his leprosy and thereby, worshipped in gratitude the God of Israel. He returned to the prophet Elisha, the man of God who interceded for him and acknowledged the Lord. He said, *"Now I know that there is no God in all the earth, except in Israel (2 Kings 5: 15) ...For I will no longer offer holocaust or sacrifice to any other god except to the Lord (2 Kings 5: 17)"*.
- ♦ Since this coming week is fall break, there will be no religious education classes. Classes resume on the week of October 20, Monday. Enjoy the break for sanity, relaxation, fun and amusement, share a laugh or two, and most of all, pray.
- ♦ Please join me in extending Fr. Marco, warmest greetings of joy, love, and peace on his 25th priesthood ordination anniversary on Tuesday, October 14, 2025 (the day of his ordination). The big party will be on Tuesday, October 28, with a Mass offered at 5:30pm, Immaculate Conception Church and a dinner at 6:30pm, CYC Hall. Please mark your calendars, and RSVP to your parish office.
- ♦ On October 26, 2025, Sunday, the 1st class relics (fragment of the bone of each of the six of the Mexican Martyrs) will visit our Catholic Community. The arrival is scheduled for 2:30pm followed by a veneration of the relics by various groups and ministries in our 3 parishes and the whole community. On this same Sunday, we will also hold our rosary celebration at 4:00pm and 5:00pm Mass, respectively. To get and learn more about this, the Knights of Columbus produced a documentary *For Greater Glory* featuring the martyrdom during the religious persecution in Mexico on the first quarter of the 20th century.
- ♦ On the weekend of November 1/2, we will celebrate in the liturgy the feast of All Souls to honor the dead.

Queridos Feligreses,

- ♦ Gracias a todos los voluntarios de la Parroquia de la Inmaculada Concepción Fiesta del Sol por un trabajo bien hecho. Hubo una gran participación no solo de los feligreses sino de toda la ciudad y más allá. La multitud era eléctrica, la comida tan deliciosa y la música una gran delicia. El entretenimiento proporcionado por los animadores (cantantes, miembros de la banda y bailarines) fue fabuloso. Creo que la multitud de personas que honraron el festival con su presencia se divirtió y relajó mucho, que es exactamente lo que necesitamos después de un día de trabajo. Gracias por apoyar la fiesta y por gastar su dinero para la casa de Dios. Gracias al comité de fiestas por todo el trabajo duro y la colaboración. Es un esfuerzo concertado para la gloria de Dios. Como siempre, la misa fue el punto culminante del evento.
- ♦ En la historia de la purificación de los Diez Leprosos, el tema de este domingo destaca la gratitud en el poder salvador y sanador de Dios. Dar gracias a Dios es primordial. Reconocer nuestras bendiciones es una señal de fe. Jesús respondió: *«Diez fueron purificados, ¿no es así? ¿Dónde están los otros nueve? ¿Nadie más que este extranjero ha regresado para dar gracias a Dios?»* El leproso no fue a ninguna parte, sino que primero se arrodilló ante los pies de Jesús en agradecimiento. Reconoció la bondad y el poder sanador de Dios. ¿Cómo es que solo un leproso regresó para dar gracias y este tipo era un extranjero (*alega*, un extranjero / forastero, es decir, alguien que realmente no pertenece)? El extranjero sanado encontró un hogar en la presencia de Dios en Cristo. En la primera lectura, Naamán, un comandante del ejército, fue sanado de su lepra y, por lo tanto, adoró en gratitud al Dios de Israel. Regresó al profeta Eliseo, el hombre de Dios que intercedió por él y reconoció al Señor. Dijo: *"Ahora sé que no hay Dios en toda la tierra, sino en Israel (2 Reyes 5:15)... Porque ya no ofreceré holocausto ni sacrificio a ningún otro dios sino al Señor (2 Reyes 5:17)"*.
- ♦ Dado que la próxima semana son las vacaciones de otoño, no habrá clases de educación religiosa. Las clases se reanudan la semana del 20 de octubre, lunes. Disfrute del descanso para la cordura, la relajación, la diversión y la diversión, comparta una risa o dos y, sobre todo, rece.
- ♦ Únase a mí para extender al P. Marco, los más cálidos saludos de alegría, amor y paz en su 25º aniversario de ordenación sacerdotal el martes 14 de octubre de 2025 (el día de su ordenación). Habrá una misa a las 9:00 am. La gran fiesta será el martes 28 de octubre, con una misa ofrecida a las 5:30 p.m., en la Iglesia de la Inmaculada Concepción y una cena a las 6:30 p.m., en el Salón CYC. Marque sus calendarios y confirme su presencia con su oficina parroquial.
- ♦ El domingo 26 de octubre de 2025, las reliquias de 1ª clase (fragmento del hueso de cada uno de los seis mártires mexicanos) visitarán nuestra Comunidad Católica. La llegada está programada para las 2:30 p.m., seguida de una veneración de las reliquias por parte de varios grupos y ministerios en nuestras 3 parroquias y en toda la comunidad. En este mismo domingo, también celebraremos nuestro rosario a las 4:00 p.m. y 5:00 p.m., respectivamente. Para obtener más información sobre esto, los Caballeros de Colón produjeron un documental *For Greater Glory* que presenta el martirio durante la persecución religiosa en México en el primer cuarto del siglo XX.
- ♦ El fin de semana del 1 y 2 de noviembre, celebraremos en la liturgia la fiesta de Todos los Fieles Difuntos para honrar a los muertos.
