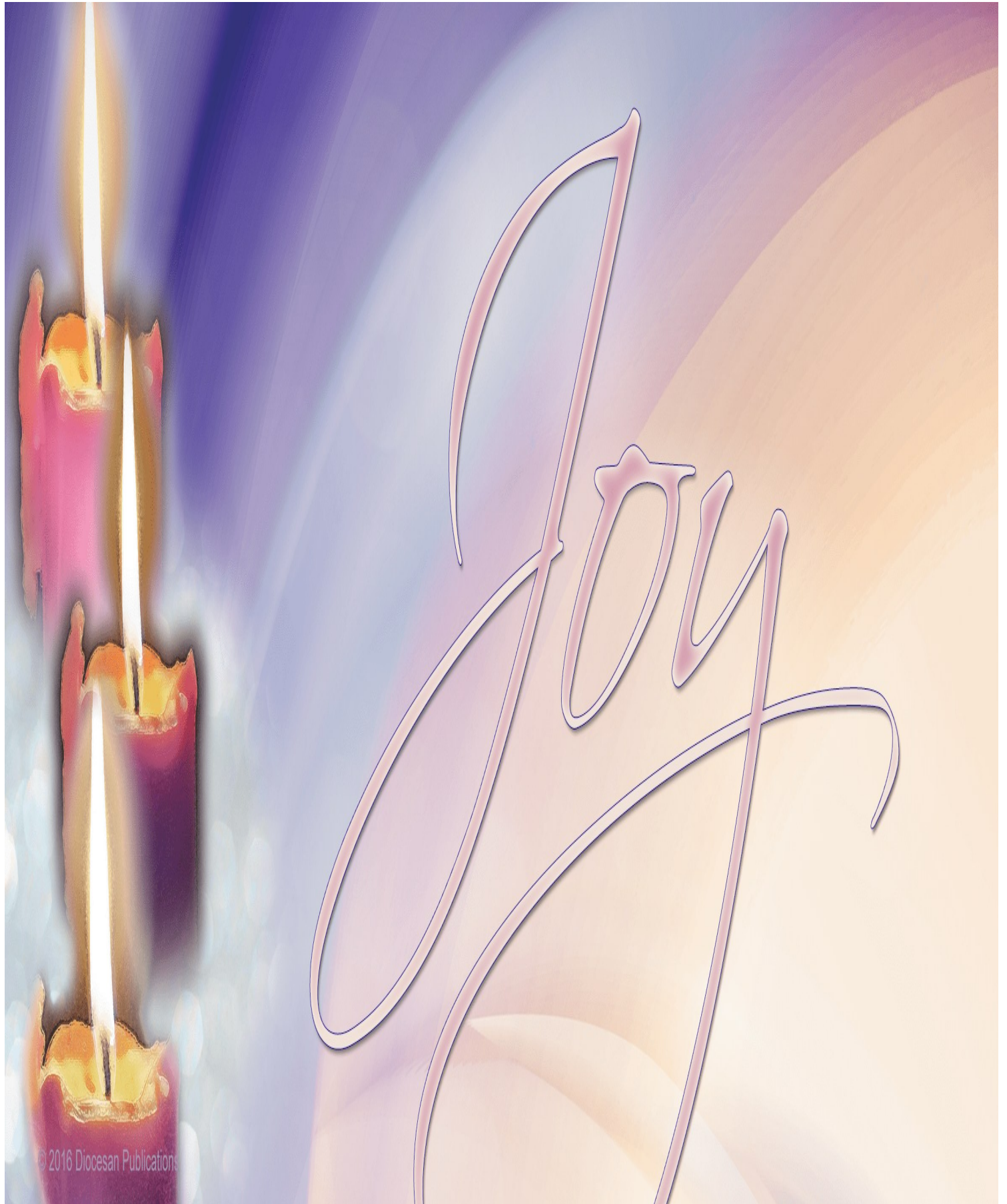

Dear Parishioners,

- ♦ Welcome to the 3rd Sunday of Advent! This Sunday, popularly called *Guadete* means Rejoice as Christmas is near. Thanks be to God there are four weeks of Advent. There is plenty of time to prepare but the thrill and excitement of the season is the waiting and the delay. There are things that cannot be rushed. Joy defines the season.
- ♦ Beginning Evening Prayer on December 17, the church meditates on the O Antiphons, the 7 titles of the long-expected Messiah, Jesus Christ and prayers recited on the last days of Advent which begins with “O” Wisdom, Adonai, Root of Jesse, Key of David, Rising Sun, King of Nations and Emmanuel. A complete list is posted in this bulletin.
- ♦ Thank you to all who participated in the Marian feasts and celebrations: the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin Mary on 12/8, Our Lady of Loreto, patroness of Loretto Catholic School and her feast day, whose memorial we celebrated on 12/10 tells us of the miraculous transfer or angelic transportation of the holy house of Virgin Mary in and from Nazareth to this place in Italy called Loreto. The name *Loreto* is taken from the Latin, *Lauretum*, a place of laurels, an evergreen bush plant which symbolizes resiliency and beauty. Its fresh and dried leaves are so fragrant that I have used them in cooking. And then, on 12/11, the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe was well participated and attended by the devotees. It was lovely seeing the community come together to celebrate the miraculous apparition of Our Lady.
- ♦ Apart from our devotion to the daily readings, if you want to go deeper, I highly recommend the recitation of the Liturgy of the Hours, the official prayer of the church, reading of the psalms (morning and evening) preferably, 6:00 am and 6:00 pm along with the Angelus. At noon or any spare time in the middle of the day, you spend a 15-minute examination of conscience. I believe this is a great way to start enriching, nourishing and sustaining our religious and spiritual lives.
- ♦ This Thursday, December 18, is our Advent Penance Service. Advent has a penitential character. The coming of the Son of God in human flesh dispels the darkness of despair, ignorance and sin. John the Baptist called us to repentance and this Sunday, he himself repented. In his greatness, he acknowledged that he didn’t know everything, not even the Messiah. That’s why he sent his disciples to ask Jesus, “Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?” The answer was not yes and no. John the Baptist leads and points his own followers and us to Christ this Thursday for penance service. There will be four priests hearing confessions. Confessions begin at 4:00 pm – 5:00 pm, St. Luke Church and resume from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm or until done. The Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation is the mercy of God. It is that simple.
- ♦ Next Monday, December 22, is the 20th anniversary of my priesthood ordination. Thank you for being part of my priestly journey, a life of service in the church. Yes, I was ordained the day after the shortest day and longest night of the year, December 21, Sunday, winter solstice, 10:03am, EST.

Queridos feligreses,

- ♦ ¡Bienvenidos al tercer domingo de Adviento! Este domingo, litúrgicamente llamado Guadate, significa Alégrate porque se acerca la Navidad. Gracias a Dios que quedan cuatro semanas de Adviento. Hay tiempo de sobra para prepararse, pero la emoción y la algarabía de la temporada de adviento radican en el retraso de la espera. Hay cosas que no se pueden apresurar. La alegría define el tiempo de espera.
- ♦ Comenzando la Oración Vespertina del 17 de diciembre, la iglesia medita sobre las Antífonas, los 7 títulos del tan esperado Mesías, Jesucristo, y las oraciones recitadas en los últimos días del Adviento, que comienzan con "Oh": Sabiduría, Adonai, Raíz de Jesse, Llave de David, Sol Naciente, Rey de las Naciones y Emanuel. En este boletín se publica la lista completa.
- ♦ Gracias a todos los que participaron en las fiestas y celebraciones marianas: la Inmaculada Concepción el 8 de diciembre, Nuestra Señora de Loreto, patrona del Colegio Católico de Loretto y su fiesta, cuyo memorial celebramos el 10 de diciembre, nos habla del milagroso traslado o transporte angelical de la santa casa de la Virgen María desde Nazaret hasta este lugar de Italia llamado Loreto. El nombre Loreto proviene del latín Lauretum, un lugar de laureles, una planta arbustiva perenne que simboliza la resiliencia y la belleza. Sus hojas frescas y secas son tan fragantes que las he usado para cocinar. Y luego, el 11 de diciembre, víspera de la fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, fue muy concurrida y asistida por los fieles devotos. Fue un deleite ver a la comunidad unirse para celebrar la milagrosa aparición de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe.
- ♦ Aparte de nuestra devoción a las lecturas diarias, si quieres profundizar más, recomiendo encarecidamente la recitación de la Liturgia de las Horas, la oración oficial de la iglesia, la lectura de los salmos (por la mañana y por la tarde), preferiblemente, a las 6:00 am y a las 6:00 pm junto con el Ángelus a las 12 pm. Al mediodía o en cualquier momento libre a mitad del día, dedicas 15 minutos a examinar tu conciencia. Creo que esta es una excelente manera de empezar a enriquecer, nutrir y sostener nuestras vidas religiosas y espirituales.
- ♦ Este jueves, 18 de diciembre, se llevará a cabo nuestro Servicio Penitencial de Adviento. Adviento tiene un carácter penitencial. La venida del Hijo de Dios en carne humana disipa la oscuridad de la desesperación, la ignorancia y el pecado. Juan el Bautista nos llamó al arrepentimiento y este domingo, él mismo mostró su arrepentimiento. En su grandeza, reconoció que no lo sabía todo, y tampoco era el Mesías. Por eso envió a sus discípulos a preguntarle a Jesús: "¿Eres tú el que va a venir, o deberíamos buscar a otro?" La respuesta fue no fue sí ni no. Juan el Bautista es el guía y así como dirigió a sus seguidores, nos guía a nosotros hacia Cristo este jueves, hacia el servicio penitencial. Habrá cuatro sacerdotes escuchando confesiones. Las confesiones serán de 4-5 p.m., en la Iglesia de San Lucas y de 6-8 p.m. En el Sacramento de la Penitencia y la Reconciliación, Dios manifiesta su misericordia. Así de fácil.
- ♦ Este lunes 22 de diciembre se cumple el vigésimo aniversario de mi ordenación sacerdotal. Gracias por ser parte en mi camino sacerdotal, una vida de servicio en la iglesia. Sí, fui ordenado el día después del día más corto y oscuro del año, el 21 de diciembre, domingo, solsticio de invierno, a las 10:03 a.m., hora del Este.

Lourdes is a single mother and is the only provider for her four children. She had been living in the United States for 27 years, working at a grocery store in Tucson. This year, on her way to pick up her youngest son, a 5-year old with autism, she stopped to get gas when two officers in black vests arrested her for no apparent reason and took her to an ICE office. "They didn't let me call the school to let them know what was happening. They denied me any chance to communicate with my children. It was so cruel!"

"All these years I've worked hard to support my kids. I have never committed a crime or even a violation, and my children are citizens. The only thing I have left is to trust that God will take care of them while I'm gone."

- Lourdes, 43 años, madre de 4 hijos y cabeza de familia. Detenida en Tucson y deportada a Nogales, Sonora

Lourdes es madre soltera y proveía para sus 4 hijos. Llevaba 27 años viviendo en Estados Unidos, trabajando en un supermercado en Tucson. Este año, en camino a recoger a su hijo menor de 5 años, quien tiene autismo, paró a poner gasolina cuando dos oficiales con chaleco negro la arrestaron sin motivo alguno y la llevaron a una oficina de ICE. “No me dejaron llamar a la escuela para avisar. ¡Qué crueldad negarme la comunicación hacia mis hijos!”

“Todos estos años he trabajado duro para sostener a mis hijos. Jamás cometí un delito o infracción y mis hijos son ciudadanos. Lo único que me queda es confiar en que Dios los cuide en mi ausencia”.

The "O Antiphons" of Advent

The Roman Church has been singing the "O" Antiphons since at least the eighth century. They are the antiphons that accompany the *Magnificat* canticle of Evening Prayer from December 17-23. They are a magnificent theology that uses ancient biblical imagery drawn from the messianic hopes of the Old Testament to proclaim the coming Christ as the fulfillment not only of Old Testament hopes, but present ones as well. Their repeated use of the imperative "Come!" embodies the longing of all for the Divine Messiah.

December 17

O Wisdom of our God Most High,
guiding creation with power and love:
come to teach us the path of knowledge!

December 18

O Leader of the House of Israel,
giver of the Law to Moses on Sinai:
come to rescue us with your mighty power!

December 19

O Root of Jesse's stem,
sign of God's love for all his people:
come to save us without delay!

December 20

O Key of David,
opening the gates of God's eternal Kingdom:
come and free the prisoners of darkness!

December 21

O Radiant Dawn,
splendor of eternal light, sun of justice:
come and shine on those who dwell in darkness and in the
shadow of death.

December 22

O King of all nations and keystone of the Church:
come and save man, whom you formed from the dust!

December 23

O Emmanuel, our King and Giver of Law:
come to save us, Lord our God!

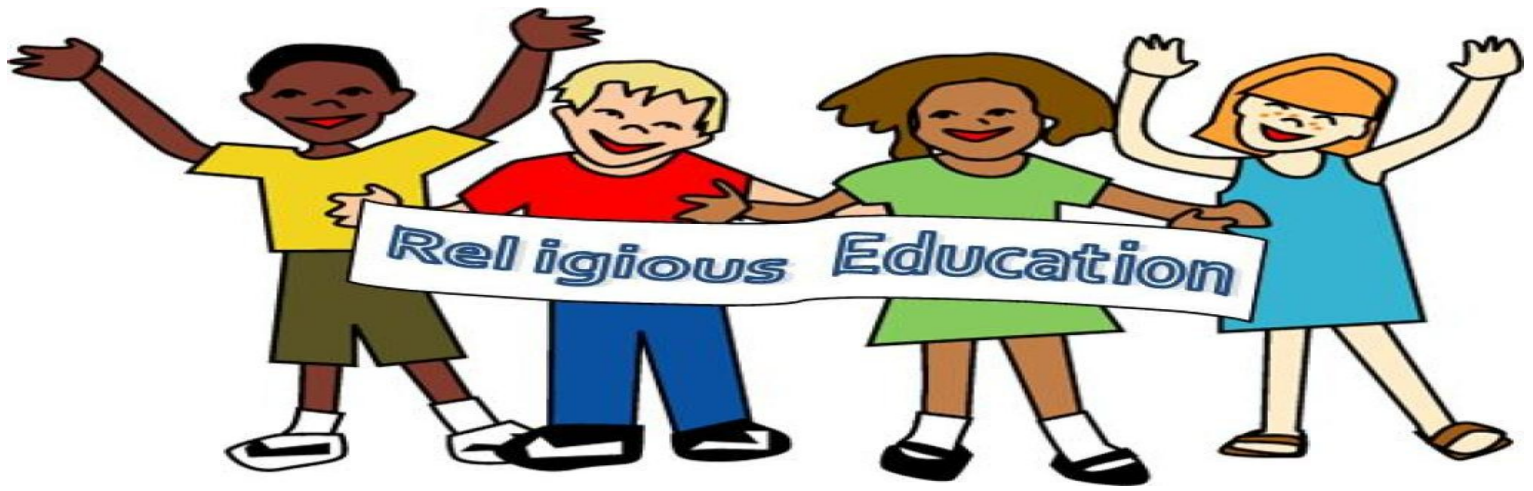
SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL
