Reach One Teach One (ROTO) is about health, community, and responsibility. This weekly peer education program gave our Teen Club an opportunity to learn about real-life issues related to sexuality, and then share that knowledge with others. While in ROTO, youth 14-18 [with prior parental permission] participate in engaging discussions, games, and activities that cover a variety of topics, including: communication skills, goal setting, relationships, consent, abstinence, birth control, decision-making, and STI/HIV/AIDS.
