BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS OF THE RED RIVER VALLEY AWARDED \$19,330 GRANT TO FUEL YOUNG PEOPLE'S BOLD AMBITIONS

Fargo, ND - August 11, 2022 — Boys & Girls Clubs of the Red River Valley received a \$19,330 grant from the Taco Bell Foundation to support teens in our community. The funds will go toward the MindWorks "Think Big!" Academic Success, Mentoring and Tutoring program, and other programs that educate and inspire the next generation of leaders. Our desired outcomes for this project include 100% grade progression of our teen members, an increase in program participation, and increased interest by the teens to continue their education.

"It's a privilege to partner with the Taco Bell Foundation in educating and inspiring young people nationwide," said Robin Nelson, CEO of Boys & Girls Club of the Red River Valley. "Together, we are working to break down barriers to education for future leaders."
