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The CLUB TEEN CENTER TAKES 3RD PLACE AND BEST OVERALL ROBOTICS AWARDS AT N.D. FIRST® LEGO® LEAGUE CHALLENGE ROBOTICS QUALIFIER, HEADING TO STATE

Wednesday, February 9, 2022 - Fargo, ND

A team of 4 teens from The CLUB Teen Center recently competed at the N.D. *FIRST*® LEGO® League (FLL) Robotics State Qualifier, held at NDSU's Bentson Bunker Fieldhouse. The team consisted of one female and three male members of The CLUB, which is the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Red River Valley's after-school youth development program for teens age 12-17.

Team "cargoCABINET" took 3rd Place out of 15 teams in the 2021-2022 CARGO CONNECT-themed competition, consisting of building and coding their LEGO robot to complete as many missions on a large game board in 2 minutes 30 seconds. The team impressed the judges with not only their technical coding and robotic mission skills, but also in the way they respectfully interacted with each other and the referees, which lead to them also winning the "Best Overall Robotics" Award. These are excellent results for a small team that, until 3 months prior, did not have any coding or robotics experience.

Team Manager and mentor Shawn Vasichek, from John Deere, initially approached The CLUB about partnering in the program. He worked with the teens and their Program Coordinator Amsey VanVolkinburg during the 3-month training period. The teens said, "This is the best Saturday ever! Coach Shawn is the best coach I've had. He's patient and doesn't just give me the answers."

Next up for Team cargoCABINET is the State *FIRST®* LEGO® League competition, Saturday, Feb. 12th in Grand Forks, ND at the UND Student Union.
