Fargo, ND June 1, 2023 – Today, Boys & Girls Clubs of the Red River Valley received a \$33,240 grant from the Taco Bell Foundation to support The CLUB Teen Center and the participating youth in our community. The funds will go toward the STEAMing to Success Program, and Life Hacks and STEAMmaker Academic Enrichment Kits, along with other programs that educate and inspire the next generation of leaders.
