Program Highlights



Through YOUR support, in the last 3 months, we have:



Family Wellness

- Joined communities across Montana in recognizing Strengthening Families Month, a statewide effort focused on prevention, family support, and child well-being.
- Supported 29 parents and caregivers in completing evidence-based parenting classes.
- Provided peer support services to 24 individuals, including 12 new participants.



Substance Abuse Prevention

- Delivered marijuana and vaping prevention education presentations, reaching over 180 individuals.
- Conducted Mental Health First Aid and Question, Persuade, Refer suicide prevention trainings.
- Continued community outreach through newsletters, podcasts, and environmental scans across 10 locations.



The Sober Life

- Supported 941 community members with Sober Life events and activities.
- Provided one-on-one peer support services to 64 individuals.
- Expanded community collaboration by partnering with Dynamic Recovery, to facilitate Wellness Recovery Action Planning groups and adopt Chowen Springs Park.



Youth Resource Center

- Served 33 new youth while continuing education, counseling, and employment support services.
- Provided 1,729 meals, 46 food boxes, and hygiene support items.
- Assisted youth with 977 transports, education, employment, and counseling support.
