SUMMER IMPACT REPORT

THIS SUMMER'S BIGGEST EVENT WAS THE BACK 2 SCHOOL BLAST!

We partnered with 30+ community organizations, along with 280+ volunteers who worked over 850 hours to provide school aged kids in Cascade County with backpacks, haircuts, immunizations, and much more!

This year was our most successful yet, with a record attendance of 1,935 people! Here's what we accomplished:

1,544 FREE BACKPACKS WERE GIVEN TO STUDENTS

1,530 PEOPLE WERE SERVED FOOD

161 KIDS RECEIVED FREE HAIRCUTS

88 KIDS RECEIVED FREE IMMUNIZATIONS

75 KIDS RECEIVED A FREE SPORTS PHYSICAL

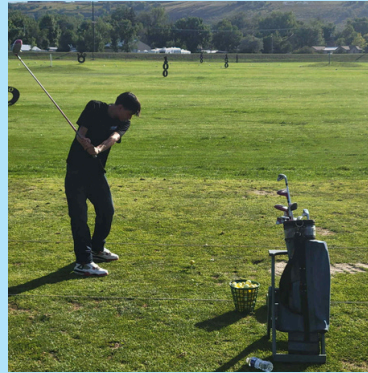




- Prime for Life – 2 classes, 18 participants
