

**ORDINANCE NO. 574**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE SALT CREEK SANITARY DISTRICT, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE DEPOSIT OF REVENUES RECEIVED FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT CHARGE INTO A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND REPLACEMENT FUND**

**WHEREAS**, the Salt Creek Sanitary District, DuPage County, Illinois (the “*District*”) has heretofore been duly established and is now operating under the provisions of an act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled “*Sanitary District Act of 1917*” (the “*Act*”), the provisions thereof being found more particularly at 70 ILCS 2405/.01, et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 17, 2023, the Board of Trustees (the “*Board*”) of the District adopted Ordinance Number 565 approving the \$8.00 fixed rate charge for the improvement and replacement of treatment facilities (the “*Fixed Rate Charge*”); and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance Number 565 established that \$7.60 of the Fixed Rate Charge shall be deposited in the District’s Improvement Fund and \$.40 of the Fixed Rate Charge shall be deposited in the District’s Replacement Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to consolidate the Improvement Fund and the Replacement Fund into one fund known as the Capital Improvement and Replacement Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board further desires to deposit the full revenues received from the Fixed Rate Charge in the District’s Capital Improvement and Replacement Fund as set forth herein and in the District’s Budget and Appropriations Ordinance for fiscal year 2025-2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined that the consolidation of funds and deposit of the full revenues received from the Fixed Rate Charge into the District’s Capital Improvement and Replacement Fund as set forth herein is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Trustees of the Salt Creek Sanitary District, DuPage County, Illinois, by and through its statutory powers, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** Beginning May 1, 2025, the revenues received from the Fixed Rate Charge shall be deposited into the District's Capital Improvement and Replacement Fund.

**Section 3.** The Board of Trustees hereby authorizes and directs the General Manager, or his designee to undertake actions on the part of the District to effectuate the terms of this Ordinance as set forth herein.

**Section 4.** The officials, officers, and employees of the District are hereby authorized to take such actions as are necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Ordinance.

**Section 5.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.


**Section 6.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 7.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
