

ORDINANCE NO. 580

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SALT CREEK SANITARY DISTRICT, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING AN INCREASED USER CHARGE FOR THE SALT CREEK SANITARY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Salt Creek Sanitary District, DuPage County, Illinois (the “*District*”) has heretofore been duly established and is now operating under the provisions of an act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled “*Sanitary District Act of 1917*” (the “*Act*”), the provisions thereof being found more particularly at 70 ILCS 2405/.01, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the District has heretofore adopted a system of charges for users of the District’s sewage treatment works; and

WHEREAS, such charges are to be established annually by ordinance duly enacted; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the “*Board*”) of the Salt Creek Sanitary District desires to authorize and approve a base user charge increase of \$.25 from \$7.75 to \$8.00 as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the approval of the base user charge increase is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Salt Creek Sanitary District, DuPage County, Illinois, by and through its statutory powers, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The base user charge shall be \$8.00 per 1,000 gallons of water usage (the “*Base User Charge*”), as determined by the appropriate water supplier, for bills issued on or after May 1, 2026.

Section 3. The result of this increase and reallocation of charges shall be that the amount of the base user rate to be placed into a fund or funds for Corporate and Operating Expenses shall be \$4.07 and the amount of the base user rate to be placed in a fund or funds earmarked for Capital Improvements including but not limited to Debt Service for the Phase 4, 5, 6, and 7 Projects shall be \$3.93.

Section 4. The Board of Trustees hereby authorizes and directs the General Manager, or his designee to undertake actions on the part of the District to effectuate the Base User Charge as set forth herein.

Section 5. The officials, officers, and employees of the District are hereby authorized to take such actions as are necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Ordinance.

Section 6. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.


Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


