**The Sacred Call of Fatherhood: Healing  
Our Wounded World**

God the Father reveals Himself as the perfect model of fatherhood—loving, protective, and eternally present. In creating man, He entrusted fathers with the sacred duty to reflect His divine paternity, forming hearts and souls within the domestic church of the family.

Saint Joseph stands as the exemplar of earthly fatherhood, silently guiding the Holy Family with strength, tenderness, and unwavering faithfulness. He teaches us that true fatherhood transcends mere biological connection; it is a spiritual mission requiring sacrifice, presence, and deep love.

When marriages fracture and fathers abandon their calling, the consequences ripple through generations. Children lose their primary witness to God's fatherly love, creating spiritual orphans who struggle to understand divine authority and unconditional love. Many adults today who never experienced the intentional presence of their fathers throughout their upbringing continue to struggle to be good fathers themselves because no one can give what they do not have except with the grace of God and intentional efforts to receive the gift of giving what you never received. Many of our communities, churches, families, and the society suffer today as

young souls, untethered from paternal guidance, seek belonging in destructive places.

The absence of fatherhood creates a void that no substitute can fully fill. Without fathers modeling integrity, work ethic, and moral courage, society loses its foundation. Boys lack examples of authentic masculinity, while girls miss the security that comes from a father's protective love.

Yet Christ calls us to hope. Every man can embrace spiritual fatherhood—whether biological fathers, priests, mentors, or community leaders. Through prayer, sacrifice, and commitment to family life, we can rebuild what has been broken.

Our world desperately needs men who will answer God's call to fatherhood either as priests or biological fathers with the same "yes" that Saint Joseph offered—quietly, completely, and with hearts surrendered to serving the next generation.







We have had some great kick ball games, some great discussions, lost of yummy snacks, and on days we can't get outside we play games inside! Here you will see us deep in a game of Jenga!


