

Our Story




In 1976 Dennis H. Doherty Sr. and his wife decided to move from their current home in South Portland, Maine to a more rural area. They found a home in Standish, Maine and soon moved in. Once settled in their new home Dennis decided to put his carpentry background to use, and so he built a picnic table for his young family to use for meals outside their new home. Once the table was constructed and put on the front lawn to use, someone pulled into the driveway and asked how much the picnic table costs.

Dennis gave them a price that he quickly came up in his head based on his costs and a marginal markup on his labor. The customer bought the picnic table and bells went off in Dennis' head, an entrepreneur was born! For several years to come he operated under the name Dennis H. Doherty & Sons, owned and operated solely by Dennis H. Doherty Sr. By 1985 the company had grown and was renamed Family Enterprises which remained until April 28, 1999, at which the company was incorporated under Shed Happens, Inc. At the time of incorporation Michael Doherty took ownership and control of 50% of Shed Happens, Inc., while Dennis H. Doherty retained 50%.

In 1996 Dennis H. Doherty Sr. retired from South Portland Fire Department after 25 years on the job. Dennis is in a current state of semi-retirement from Shed Happens, Inc. He still works with the Amish vendors for the resale sector of Shed Happens, Inc.

In 1997 Michael Doherty graduated from University of Southern Maine with a Bachelor Degree in Business Management and a minor in Accounting. Michael has worked with the Shed Happens business since its inception. Currently Michael and his son Chance Doherty manage all facets of Shed Happens, Inc.

Gable A Frame

The **Gable A-Frame shed** is our base model and is built to the same high quality and material standards of our other buildings. The Gable A-Frame style sheds have a low 5/12 A roof pitch, minimal overhangs, 76" sidewalls, all siding options available.

Gable A Frame sheds 8' x 8' and smaller come standard with a 4' double door and (1) window. 8' x 10' sheds and larger come standard with a 5' double door and (2) windows.



Extended Gable

The **Extended Gable shed** is our most popular shed model. It comes with 6" taller walls, steeper 7/12 roof pitch, 6" overhangs on rakes and eaves and wider gable and fascia trim. This is a very classy looking building that will compliment any home.

Extended Gable sheds 8' x 8' and smaller come standard with a 4' double door and (1) window. 8' x 10' sheds and larger come standard with a 5' double door and (2) windows.



Quaker

Our **Quaker shed model** has a unique design where the front wall is about 12" higher than the rear wall, which gives the roof a bit of an offset. It also has an 18" overhang on the front with small overhangs on the other three sides. Quaker comes with all siding options.

Quaker sheds 8' x 8' and smaller come standard with a 4' double door and (1) window. 8' x 10' sheds and larger come standard with a 5' double door and (2) windows.



Gambrel

Our **Gambrel model** is very similar to our standard Gable A-Frame, except with a Gambrel roof. The Gambrel roof is very much a "barn style" which provides some additional overhead space and the barn aesthetics. The Gambrel style has minimal overhangs on rakes and eaves and the arrangement of doors and windows is free.

Gambrel sheds 8' x 8' and smaller come standard with a 4' double door and (1) window. 8' x 10' sheds and larger come standard with a 5' double door and (2) windows.



Extended Gable W/ Dormer

The **Extended Gable with dormer shed** is a popular shed model like the normal Extended Gable shed, It comes with 6" taller walls, steeper 7/12 roof pitch, 6" overhangs on rakes and eaves and wider gable and fascia trim as well as a shed dormer with transom windows which lets in additional natural lighting. This too is a very classy looking building that will compliment any home. Perfect style for a home office!

Extended Gable sheds 8' x 8' and smaller come standard with a 4' double door and (1) window. 8' x 10' sheds and larger come standard with a 5' double door and (2) windows.



2-Story Buildings





Our two standard 2-Story models include the 2-Story Extended Gable and the 2-Story Extended Gambrel, which are completely customizable. These buildings come with a full second floor, which can be accessed by L-shape, straight, or pull down stairs. These buildings come standard with a 12/12 roof pitch, 93" wall height (7'6" studs), 6" overhangs on the rakes and eaves with 5.5" fascia and gable trim. Because the 2-Story buildings have a full second floor, this makes them too tall to haul down the road completely assembled. However, If we have enough clearance (roughly 2' wider than the width of the shed) then we can deliver the bottom portion of the shed whole with our 1-ton truck and flatbed trailer that is specifically designed to deliver sheds! Then we will either stick build or use a boom truck/ crane to set the roof/ second floor on and secure the two pieces together!

Rampage Door System With plenty of room for your tractor, ATV or snowmobile this door doubles as a ramp and when closed up looks just like a normal door!

Site Prep

Proper site location and preparation will help ensure a smooth installation and minimize settling over time and is the sole responsibility of the homeowner.

CAUTION: If your door/ramp is on a downward sloping side, your ramp may be too steep. Build up the ground on that side to decrease slope angle.

PERMITS: Please note that permits are the responsibility of the property owner. Please check with your local building department for requirements. Shed Happens, Inc. has experience working with many building departments in Maine. If you need assistance please call us at 207-494-7546 and we'd be glad to assist.

DIY: In most situations site preparation can be done easily by the property owner. Either the site is nearly level or the homeowner can correct it by spreading a small amount of gravel. (See the directions below.) In situations where the grade is significantly out of level the homeowner can address it themselves or contract the work. If the property owner decides to put down a crushed stone pad, Shed Happens, Inc. recommends using 1 1/2" of crushed stone (that being the stone size), making the pad 4-6 inches thick, and 2 feet bigger than the shed.

Select the EXACT location for your new building PRIOR to the delivery date.

Once you've selected the site, consider the following:

Mark the site using stakes to locate the four corners of the building.

A three (3) foot clear work area perimeter is necessary for our crews to place your building.

The site must be FLAT and LEVEL. FIGURES 2 & 3.

Frequently, customers assume because the ground is flat it is level. The building should be installed on a FLAT and LEVEL surface to function properly and be aesthetically pleasing.

To determine if your building site is level use a LINE LEVEL - FIGURE 4

Check to see if there is a slope in the site. Locate the highest corner point of the proposed building site and using the line level determine location irregularities.





 $12\,x\,14$ extended gable shed leveled with concrete patio blocking. (our standard delivery setup)

A LINE LEVEL can be purchased at most hardware stores or home centers for less than \$2

From the stake at the highest point of the site (A) run a string to each of the other three stakes and check with a line level. The string should be tied snug to the ground on stake A (the high point). The distance between the string and the ground at stakes D, C and B must be 10 inches or less. If the distance is greater than ten inches, the site will need alterations.


The site may be altered by re grading the area. CUT out the higher area of the site. If the materials removed are unstable (Loam or sand) you may want to add gravel to the site. If the material cut from the slope is used for fill, locate the building on the cut portion of the site.

If the site is within the (10) ten inch limitation we can shim the building using concrete blocks. CAUTION: Distances greater than ten (10) inches can make the building unstable and unsafe. The site must be leveled.

If the building is to be constructed on concrete sono tubes, pressure treated $6" \times 6"$ posts or a concrete slab, the work must be completed at least five (5) days prior to delivery to allow for the proper concrete curing time. NOTE - If you plan to install concrete sono tubes we will provide you with a FOOT PRINT drawing and instructions to assist you with proper installation and alignment. The site must be clear of all debris including brush, stumps, animal waste and other impediments. Trees located in the general area must not have branches hanging over the site closer than thirteen (13) feet from the ground. Please allow for access of delivery truck to the site.

Inclement weather may necessitate delivery delays. We will contact you to reschedule a new delivery date.

If site is not prepared & is unsafe to build, a fee of \$150.00 will be charged for our crew to return for assembly.

Shed Delivery & Expectations

Most buildings are delivered fully assembled and ready for same-day use. Deliveries are normally made Monday - Friday between the hours of 7am and 6pm. While it is difficult to give an exact time, we can usually tell you if your building will be arriving in the morning or afternoon. You may also request a specific date, take delivery as soon as possible, or leave delivery open and call us when you are ready. It is important for customers to give the delivery crew space while they are delivering the shed to prevent any injury from occurring to the customer or delivery crew.







What we expect from you, the customer, to make your delivery experience exceed your expectations:

<u>Delivery Procedure</u>: Prior to delivery, there will be a set block of time assigned that Shed Happens will arrive within; if there will be any changes to those times, Shed Happens will make every effort to notify you as soon as is feasible. A typical delivery takes 30 minutes. For your safety, please make sure to give our delivery people space until the shed is delivered, leveled, and ready to go. To ensure the shed is in great shape, and for a speedy yet safe delivery, please make sure the area is prepared as follows:

- There is a path to the desired area at least 2' wider than the size of your storage shed
- Any and all low tree limbs will be removed before delivery
- The area is cleared of all debris, including animal feces
- All vehicles in your driveway/lot will be removed prior to delivery
- Any power lines that hang low will be brought to the attention of Shed Happens before delivery
- The desired area is measured exactly and staked out in the 4 corners you want the shed (once the shed is set down directly on the stakes, this is where it is to stay)
- Setbacks are already measured out before Shed Happens arrives; show the drivers the setback marks
- Be aware if you have a ramp, 5' needs to be available to place it
- Sprinkler heads, wells, septic tanks, and anything we cannot see that may get damaged if a 1-ton pickup truck drives over it needs to be marked.
- Payment is due in full at time of Delivery.


