

Pre-Travel Checklist

INTERIOR

- ☐ Locking Bolts on Fridge tray slides and Kitchen slides are locked in place before moving your trailer
- ☐ Dead lock on Entry door engaged and locked before moving trailer.
- ☐ Roof closed and locked. Make sure there is no canvas tent sticking out underneath the seals.
- ☐ All lockers and drawers securely closed and dead bolts engaged.
- ☐ Secure all appliances.
- ☐ Refrigerator packed securely – door locked.
- ☐ Fire extinguisher is located inside the camper trailer and correctly secured
- ☐ All large and heavy items in drawers and compartments are secured properly to prevent movement in transport
- ☐ Strip lighting cables have not been damaged during closure of the Camper Trailer
- ☐ Stereo power has been switched off and power isolated at Batteries
- ☐ Air conditioner has been turned off
- ☐ Gas bottles turned off - Gas cooker locked, and stove top lid secured
- ☐ TV removed from roof of camper and secured (Navigators only)

- ☐ Cushions have been laid down prior to closing the camper trailer.
- ☐ Camper trailer has been packed to ensure correct weight distribution
- ☐ Batteries have been fully charged
- ☐ Navigator models with internal toilet/shower raise the mirror before lowering the roof

EXTERIOR

- ☐ Tyres - check pressure and adjust including spares
- ☐ **Check whether wheel nuts are present and tightened to manufacturers specifications.**
- ☐ Brakes checked and adjusted.
- ☐ Water tank filled. Note- rear water tank can be filled to help set correct ball weight, it is customers responsibility to check and set ball weight correct before each trip.
- ☐ Lights operating correctly.
- ☐ Wheel bearings checked for no loose abnormal movement of the wheel
- ☐ Jockey wheel has been raised and secured.
- ☐ Trailer coupling attached to the tow vehicle securely locked in position.
- ☐ Doors locked - steps raised and locked in place. Deadlock on main door engaged.
- ☐ Jacks and support legs raised.
- ☐ Release handbrake - remove wheel chocks if used.
- ☐ Safety chains secured to the tow vehicle in a cross over pattern under the hitch.
- ☐ Adjust towing mirrors if used.
- ☐ Air Con Vent Covers are closed (located underneath the camper trailer)
- ☐ 240v electrical extension lead disconnected.
- ☐ Positive Pressure system has been turned on (if fitted)
- ☐ Boat loaders and/or items located on top of the camper trailer have been loaded to ensure correct weight distribution.
- ☐ Winch strap secured correctly
- ☐ 7Pin trailer plug and anderson plug have been correctly attached to tow vehicle and electric brakes function correctly
- ☐ Registration plate has not been obscured by objects installed in the rear bike carrier receiver
- ☐ Grey water tanks have been emptied (if required)
- ☐ Toilet canister has been emptied (if required)
