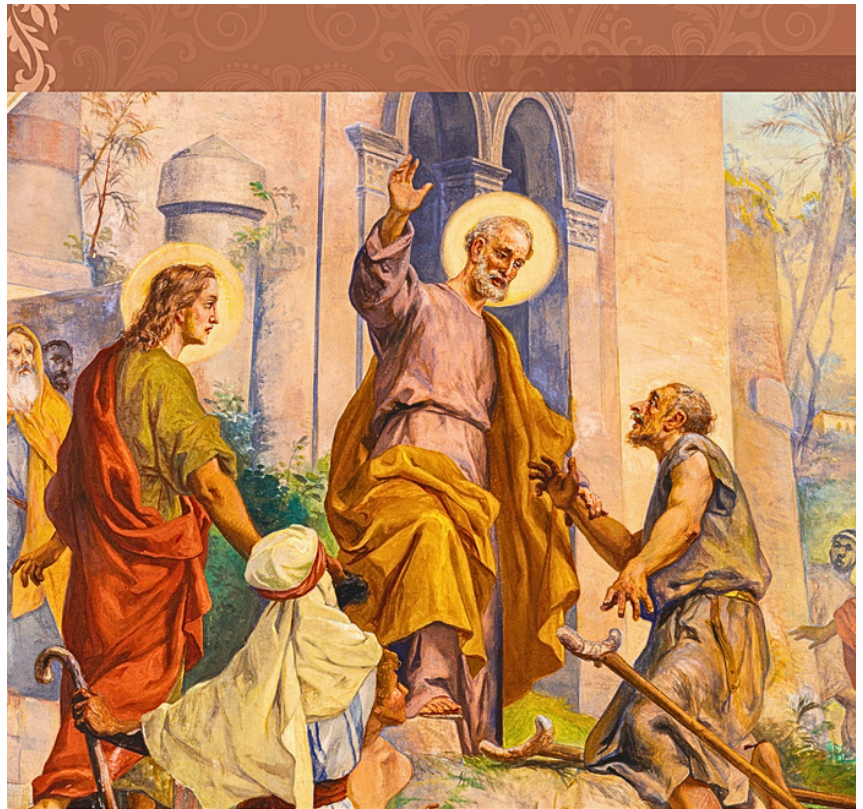

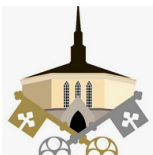

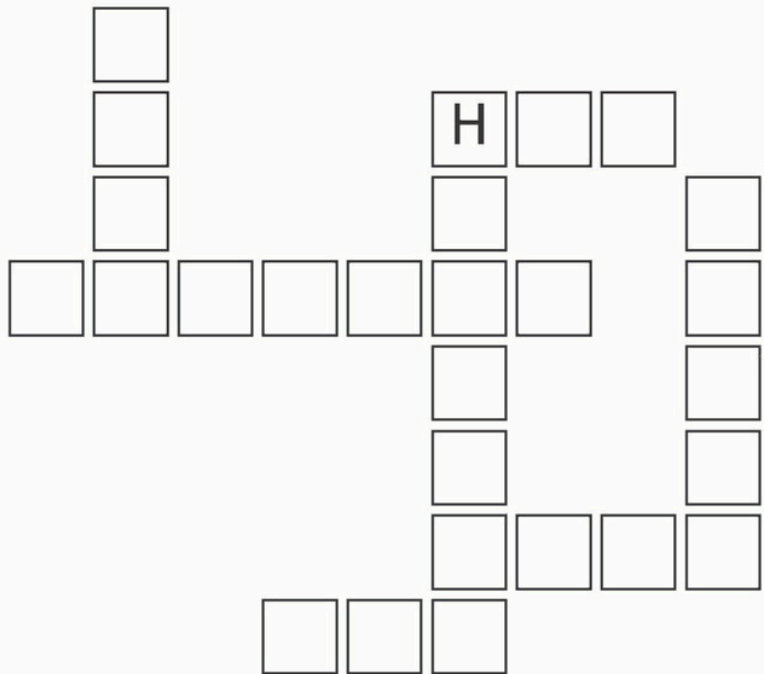

St Vincent de Paul Newsletter

We receive calls weekly from neighbors who need assistance with rent, utilities, food and other needs. We visit them on the telephone, in their homes and motel lobbies. We use your generous donations to help them get over the bumps in the road that we all face at times. We also work with other churches and organizations as well as the state SVDP group for the larger needs of our neighbors.

Recently we assisted a woman who had been in prison over 10 years, had her conviction overturned and was starting over with nothing. She found a job and obtained a car but could not keep up with her rent nor furnish her apartment. We were able to, with the help of the wonderful CCW ladies, give her furniture donated for the yard sale and assist with rent and food. She is now working to regain custody of her child. She thanked us tearfully and said that we were a Godsend to her.

We were also able to assist a neighbor with 6 children who was working but homeless. One of her children has medical needs that require her to go to Atlanta monthly. With rental assistance programs from the state SVDP as well as your donations, we helped her get into a new home for herself and her children.

If you find yourself, family members or friends who are encountering bumps in the road, please let us know. Our calls, records and assistance are confidential. Our call line number is 706-884-0076, open Monday from 9:00AM until we receive 10 callers. You can also call the church office.

If you find yourself called to volunteer, please let us know. We have several areas that you can assist with, such as food pantry, counting the monthly collection, annual golf tournament, holiday food delivery, taking calls and making home visits. Recibimos llamadas semanalmente de vecinos que necesitan ayuda con el alquiler, los servicios públicos, alimentos y otras necesidades. Los visitamos por teléfono, en sus hogares y en los vestíbulos de moteles. Utilizamos sus generosas donaciones para ayudarles a superar los obstáculos que todos enfrentamos en algún momento. También trabajamos con otras iglesias y organizaciones, así como con el grupo estatal de SVDP, para atender las necesidades más grandes de nuestros vecinos.

Recientemente ayudamos a una mujer que había estado en prisión por más de 10 años, cuya condena fue anulada y que estaba comenzando de nuevo sin nada. Ella encontró trabajo y consiguió un automóvil, pero no podía mantenerse al día con el alquiler ni amueblar su apartamento. Pudimos, con la ayuda de las maravillosas damas de CCW, proporcionarle muebles donados para la venta de garaje y ayudarle con el alquiler y la comida. Ahora está trabajando para recuperar la custodia de su hijo. Nos agradeció entre lágrimas y dijo que fuimos una bendición de Dios para ella.

También pudimos ayudar a una vecina con 6 hijos que estaba trabajando, pero sin hogar. Uno de sus hijos tiene necesidades médicas que requieren viajar a Atlanta mensualmente. Con programas de asistencia para el alquiler del SVDP estatal, así como con sus donaciones, la ayudamos a conseguir un nuevo hogar para ella y sus hijos.

Si usted, familiares o amigos se encuentran enfrentando dificultades, por favor háganoslo saber. Nuestras llamadas, registros y asistencia son confidenciales. Nuestro número de atención es 706-884-0076, abierto los lunes a partir de las 9:00 AM hasta recibir 10 llamadas. También puede llamar a la oficina de la iglesia. The Power of a Simple Action

I remember seeing a story on a morning news program about a little girl who wanted to give an elderly man in a grocery store a hug. She had no way of knowing that this man had just lost his wife of many years and now felt so very alone and depressed. Her reaching out to the man seemed odd to her mom at first, but the girl was so insistent about giving a hug she moved the shopping carts close together so the exchange could take place. No one knew that from that moment on the little girl would ask to visit her new friend at least once a week for the next four years until he passed away. In an interview soon after the initial encounter, the man said, "I haven't been this happy in some time." Imagine the joy that relationship brought to them both over the years!

It was just a moment. It was a simple gesture. Yet, it had a large impact that no one could have predicted. You never know what will result when we give just a little of ourselves. That uncertainty too often leads us to hold back or refrain from the simple actions of love or gestures of generosity that could come so easily for us if we wanted. We should never doubt the power of a simple random act of kindness. Generosity does not need to be grand to make a big difference. The time is now, and the opportunity presents itself often to plant a small seed that God can water and nourish so that something beautiful can grow.

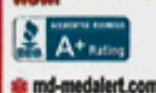
