TERMS OF ELECTION

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING 4A AND PROVIDING FOR TWO YEAR STAGGERED TERMS FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS DETERMINED BY AN AT LARGE ELECTION.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN:

The City of Log Cabin shall change current election process deemed to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Log Cabin that their seat holders shall serve two-year staggered terms.


That the terms of office of the Mayor and the Councilmembers shall continue to be staggered, which shall be determined by an at large election. Each position shall be elected for a two-year term each, beginning this current election of 2022 and continuing annually hereafter.

An at large election allows citizens to run for a councilmember in a general way; without particularizing. Any citizen running for the position of Mayor must still choose Mayor on their application.
