

ORDINANCE NO. 60

An Ordinance of the City of Log Cabin, Texas prohibiting the placement of any type sign or advertisement on or around the big oak tree (in the middle of Alamo Road) or any trees on a public right of way, and providing for a penalty.

Whereas, because of the conditions prevailing within the City of Log Cabin, Texas that detract from the appearance, and traffic flow of the City, it is necessary to prohibit the placement of these signs.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Log Cabin, Texas, the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Ordinance upon his determination that such implementation is necessary to improve the appearance of the City and to protect the public safety from slowing or stopping to place or read these signs.

Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty upon conviction in the Municipal Court and shall be fined \$15.00 to \$50.00.

The violation, as long as it remains, shall be deemed a separate violation and shall be punished accordingly.
