ORDINANCE NO. 64

An Ordinance of the City of Log Cabin, Texas making it unlawful for any person to trespass upon, interfere with or use property of another person without written consent of the owner or person in charge of such property, and providing for a penalty.

Whereas, because of conditions prevailing within the City of Log Cabin, Texas it is necessary to prohibit the unlawful use of another persons property.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Log Cabin, Texas, the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Ordinance upon his determination that such implementation is necessary to protect the rights of the owners of their private property from unlawful interference.

Any person found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty upon conviction in the Municipal Court and shall be fined \$100.00 to \$200.00. The violation, for as long as it remains, shall be deemed a separate violation and shall be punished accordingly.
