ORDINANCE 7B

FIREWORKS

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE DISPLAY OF FIREWORKS OF ANY KIND IN THE CITY LIMITS OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LOG CABIN THAT ORDINANCE 7 SHALL BE UPDATED AND TAKE EFFECT AT THE DATE AND TIME AT WHICH IT WAS SIGNED.

SECTION I:

It shall be unlawful to shoot, cast, throw, display, or exhibit any type of fireworks including but not limited to any rockets, firecrackers, torpedoes, or sparklers within the city limits of Log Cabin, Henderson County, Texas. Fireworks are strictly prohibited in Log Cabin City Limits.

SECTION II:

There are two exceptions to this ordinance, as follows:

- 1. The City of Log Cabin may formally choose to present a grand fireworks show for the 4th of July. Such presentation or show must be held on the shoreline of the lake in the Family Lake Area and must have representatives from the Log Cabin Volunteer Fire Department (LCVFD) and Log Cabin Police Department (LCPD).
- 2. If the City of Log Cabin chooses to present a fireworks show, they may also choose whether to provide an area for citizens to use their own fireworks under the supervision and inspection of the LCVFD and LCPD.

An annual resolution will need to be passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Log Cabin at the regularly scheduled monthly council meeting in June, to decide if the city will approve exceptions #1 and/or #2; or not allowing either. The passing of this resolution must be done every year and must be done prior to July 1st of that same year.

SECTION III:

Any Person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be fined an amount not to exceed the sum of \$500.00.
