ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING AND ESTABLISHING GUIDELINES FOR VOLUNTEER WORK TO BE PERFORMED BY CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCERNING CITY PROPERTY AND/OR ACTIVITIES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Log Cabin, Texas recognizes that resources in both personnel and equipment can often times be limited; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further recognizes that City Council members have certain experience and talents that may, from time to time, provide benefit to the City in the form of volunteer work on City property and/or related to City activities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passes this Ordinance authorizing City Council members to provide temporary volunteer services to the City and provide regulations concerning same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:

I. AUTHORIZATION AND REGULATIONS

- A. By the passage of this Ordinance, the City Council for the City of Log Cabin, Texas, hereby authorized City Council members to perform temporary volunteer services as may be necessary concerning City property and/or activities that benefit the City and its citizenry.
- B. A City Council member providing the type of services referenced in 1(A) shall do so at their own risk and shall release the City, its officers, employees and all those in privity with the City from any and all claims and damages, both to person and property that may arise due to their volunteer activities. Such release shall be executed by the Council member prior to performing their volunteer services.
- C. A City Council member providing volunteer services to the City shall do so on a temporary bases. Should such volunteer services require repetitive services or filling in for an absent City employee, said services may not exceed six (6) months in duration.

II. SEVERABILITY

Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Ordinance be deems invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Ordinance.

III. REPEALER

To the extent reasonably possible, ordinances are to be read together in harmony. However, all ordinances, or parts thereof, that are in conflict of inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the City Council for the City of Log Cabin, Texas.
