From FR. C.P.

We, Christians, consider marriage as a lifelong covenantal relationship based on faith and commitment. This is amply taught in the teachings of the Catholic Church on the theology of the sacrament of matrimony. However, unfortunately there are quite a few who have to go through hard decisions of separating from a spousal relationship, sometimes after being together for several years. The Church in her motherly concern for the separated individuals makes room for remarriages after going through a process of annulment. An annulment is not a divorce, but a declaration by the Church that due to the absence of the required conditions for a valid marriage, the marriage never took place or simply put, the marriage celebrated was not a valid one. That is called the nullity of a marriage. To help married couples considering having an annulment decree issued to them by the Church in terms of getting the materials/documents needed to apply for it, some people from a few parishes in our dioceses have received a special training in recent weeks. They are usually called 'nullity ministers'. If you or your dear ones are in the category of those who are in need of going for an annulment, and would require help through the process, kindly approach me. I could direct you to where the help can be available. Let's pray always for married couples that their efforts to stay together in love and fidelity may be blessed by the Lord abundantly, who has put them together. "What God has joined together, let no human put asunder." (Matthew 19:6)
