From FR C.P

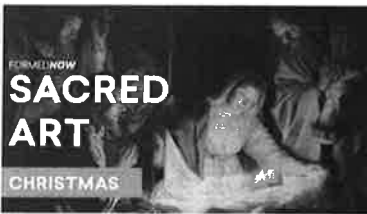

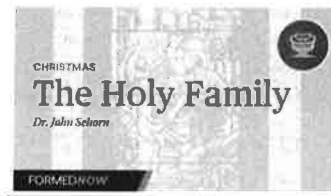
