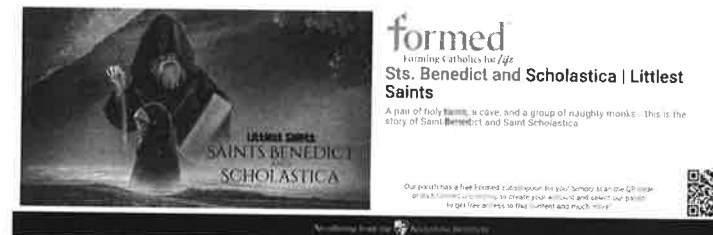

Catholic Living:

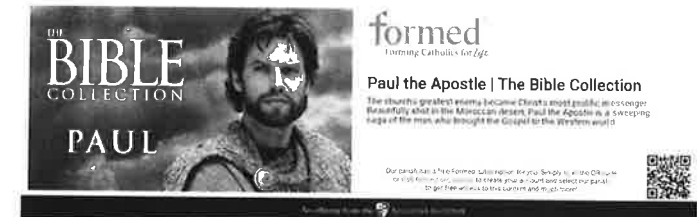
