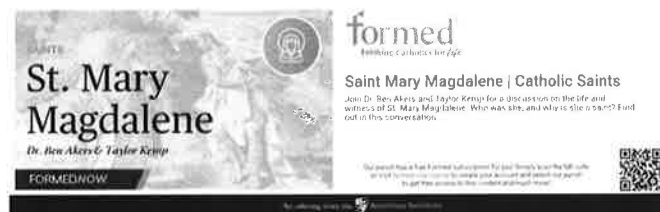

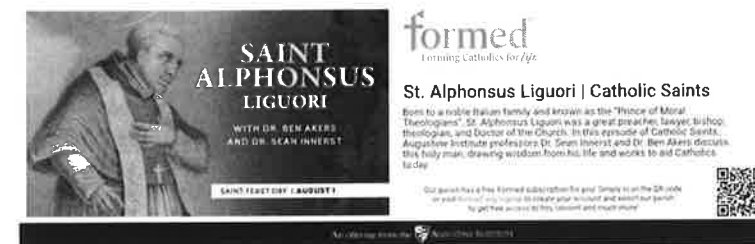

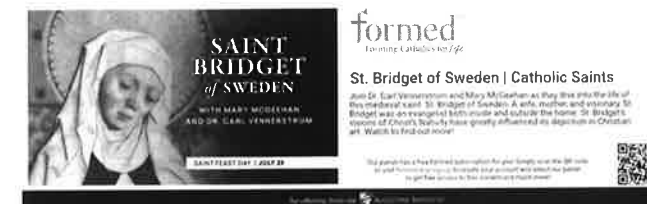
Compassion, Barriers and God
