Catholic Living The Eucharist in Daily Life

- 1. In the Eucharistic Liturgy and our prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, we encounter God's presence in personal and profound ways. But the Eucharist is also social, as Pope Benedict XVI reminds us...'A Eucharist which does not pass over into the concrete practice of love is intrinsically fragmented.'
- 2. The Eucharist is a sign of our incomparable dignity as human persons. This dignity, given equally to all, regardless of social or economic status or where we come from causes us to recognize 'what value each person, our brother or sister, has in God's eyes, if Christ offers Himself equally to each one...If our Eucharistic worship is authentic, it must make us grow in awareness of the dignity of each person. (Pope John Paul II)

The Risen Christ in the Eucharist acts as 'a compelling force for inner renewal, an inspiration to change the structures of sin...These structures include racism, violence, injustice, poverty, exploitation, and all other systemic degradation of human life or dignity.
