From FR. C.P.:

As you might be aware, each month, the pope has a special intention that he requests all of us who are worldwide to pray for. The papal intention for March 2026 is for **disarmament and peace**. "Let us pray that nations move forward (towards) effective disarmament, particularly nuclear disarmament, and that world leaders choose the path of dialogue and diplomacy instead of violence." In the wake of the disastrous war that is spreading in the Middle East and West and Central Asia, the pope says, "I am following with deep concern what is happening in the Middle East and in Iran during this tumultuous time. Stability and peace are not achieved through mutual threats, not through the use of weapons, which sow destruction, suffering, and death, but only through reasonable, sincere, and responsible dialogue." Let us in this context remember also what Pope Francis has once said: "There is no victory in a war. Everything is defeated. May the Lord send his spirit to make us understand that instead we need to defeat war. May the spirit of the Lord free us all from this self-destructive need that is manifested in waging war." Let us continue to pray that humaneness and sensibility prevail in the hearts of all those who are responsible for this war.


