We have started a new fiscal year on July 1st, 2026. One of these days, I was looking at the spreadsheet of our income-expenditure of last year. Although we have reasons for feeling satisfied overall, there are areas where we can improve. We have definitely cut down our expenses in several areas over the past few years. Sometimes, it is not possible to do so. The unexpected expenses do occur. The re-roofing of the church has been recently completed as you have noticed. Most of its expenses were covered by insurance. In this connection, we are grateful to two of our trustees/directors (Dan Schoening and Keith Nienhueser) for looking into the maintenance of all of our properties. Modification of staff patterns was done during the past few years, so we could save on wages/salaries. One thing that we would like to see improvement in, is the area of tithing. Many people, but not all, do take seriously their duty of contributing to the church for its running. Some people donate for specific programs of the parish such as outreach ministry. We appreciate their kindness and generosity. And it is not just our money that we are called to share, but also our talents and time. It is good to see new ministers for liturgical services. But some people forget to find substitutes when they are away during their allocated days. We would like to see more volunteers in all the various ministries and services of the church. Thus let us continue to bear witness to Christ and to his gospel whatever way we are called to do.
