Option for the Poor and Vulnerable is one of the basic tenets of Catholic Social Teaching, or, how our faith affects our daily life. This tenet is described as follows, "A basic moral test is how our most vulnerable members are faring. In a society marred by deepening divisions between rich and poor, our tradition recalls the story of the Last Judgment (Mt 25:31-46) and instructs us to put the needs of the poor and vulnerable first." In our country today we are faced with deepening divisions over how we live this tenet, and who falls into this category. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops website teaches through Scripture and Tradition, outlining parameters that are helpful in prayer and discernment on this topic. It can be found by searching, "Option for the Poor and Vulnerable, USCCB." "The Church's love for the poor . . . is a part of her constant tradition.' This love is inspired by the Gospel of the Beatitudes, of the poverty of Jesus, and of his concern for the poor. . . . 'Those who are oppressed by poverty are the object of a preferential love on the part of the Church which, since her origin and in spite of the failings of many of her members, has not ceased to work for their relief, defense, and liberation'." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, nos. 2444, 2448, quoting *Centesimus annus*, no. 57, and *Libertatis conscientia*, no. 68)
Let us pray for wisdom, compassion and right judgement in this particular time in our beloved country.
