# U.S. bishops' president begs Americans to see Christ 'in every person', reject political violence

Five years after the release of Pope Francis' encyclical on fraternal love, and amid a rise in political violence, the leader of the U.S. Catholic bishops, (Archbishop Broglio), is pleading for a rediscovery of -and respect for-a common humanity."

Following are 4 quotes from his reflection in an Oct 1 pastoral invitation for reflection, any of which can be rich food for our own reflection. "We have seen the manifestation of this notion in the perverse ideas that one can serve the common good by becoming an instrument of violence. This happens when we refuse to see the face of Christ in the other person and only see an enemy that must be dominated or destroyed" "Each of us should examine our hearts, our thoughts, and our actions and ask ourselves how we contribute to the polarization and animosity plaguing our nation."

"Pray for your enemies."

He concluded his reflection with a call to pray "that we may discover anew that all are important and all are necessary, different faces of the one humanity that God so loves. Amen"
