Our clam chowder is made from scratch – at least one day before we serve it, so the flavor is at its peak. (Like a good spaghetti sauce, always better on the second day!) We cut our own steaks daily - a generous 12 oz. US Choice boneless sirloin strip steak fresh – never frozen. You can taste the difference. The same is true with our chicken – purchased fresh and broiled with a barbecue sauce developed by Cornell University without sugar, so it doesn't burn. Of course, all our seafood is purchased fresh locally. You get the idea – we do it right!
