Old Business:

Payden Park Update – The chain link fence repairs from storm damage is complete. Replaced 20-feet of fencing and bent pipes.

Pine River Cemetery – A bid has been submitted from Gate's Drilling to bore a water line 200 feet east and move the current hydrant to that location. Gate's Drilling prefers to leave the current hydrant and add a new hydrant 200 feet to the east. Bid amount \$4,550.00 Recommendation to place trash barrel by hydrant in hopes it doesn't get backed into again. This project has been put on hold for future consideration.

New Business:

Request for Millbrook Rolland Fire Department to cost share with Rolland Township for use of the dumpster at the Firebarn for trash bags accumulated at Pine River Cemetery. Spring and Fall clean-up would be the largest use. The Board agrees to cost share with MRFD up to \$300/year

Community Concern with Amish horse manure on Main Street. The Sheriff's Department has advised the Board that the "Apple Core Rule" applies to the biodegradable refuse left by animals on public roads. The horse droppings while inconvenient, even annoying, do not constitute a legal violation. They will not pursue any prosecution regarding this issue. Passing a meaningless and unenforceable ordinance regarding this issue would be pointless for Rolland Township, however, Supervisor Shaw will reach out to the Amish Community asking them to kindly clean up after the horses in Blanchard.
