



The Watertown Transportation Management Association (TMA) is a public/private non-profit that works to address transportation concerns in the region by promoting the benefits of driving less and taking transit, shuttles, carpooling, biking, and walking. The Watertown TMA works with its business, residential, and community partners to develop and promote sustainable transportation programs.

The Watertown TMA is overseen by a Board of Directors comprised of members of the organization who are responsible for implementing the workplan for the group. The TMA has established a seat on the Board for an **Advisory Member** who is a Watertown resident. This would be a **non-voting** participant who would attend TMA meetings and could contribute to the overall mission of the organization. The ideal candidate would be an individual with a strong interest in transportation issues who is a current participant in another transportation or health initiative such as The Watertown Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee, Live Well Watertown, the Watertown Faces Climate Change or another local or regional group. In addition to participating in Board Meetings, the Advisory Member may be asked to assist the TMA in working with municipal officials, legislators, state officials, and other leaders to advocate for our region's needs. Currently, Board Meetings occur once a quarter, at 9:00 AM.
