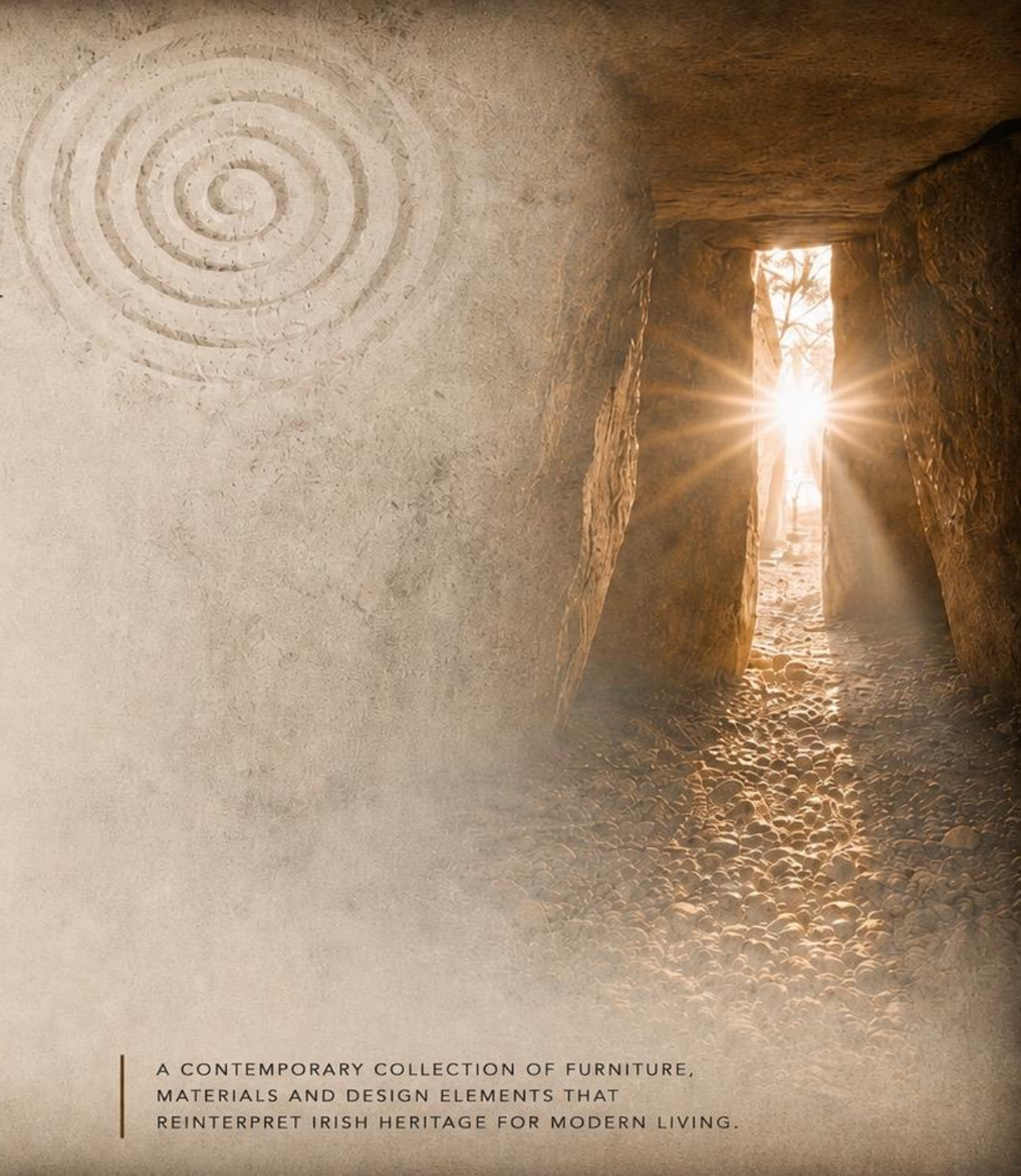
04 PURPOSE

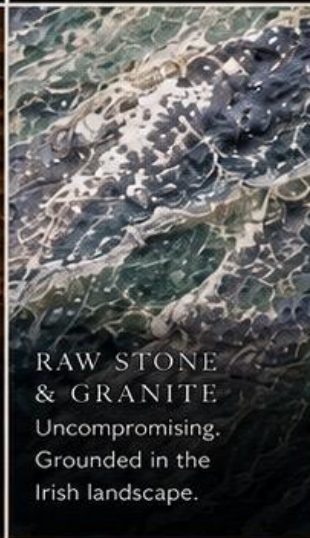

Textured timber, carved surfaces, geometric relief patterns, layered materials and sculptural detailing create opportunities for kitchen furniture, wall panelling, acoustic solutions, architectural screens and bespoke interior features.

Origin

Dún Briste, County Mayo

Named after the iconic sea stack off the north Mayo coast, the Dún Briste Whiskey Bar begins with place. Its layered composition, projecting forms and sculptural silhouette echo the geology and drama of Ireland's Atlantic edge.

Stone, timber, linen, metal and light are brought together as a contemporary expression of the landscape — elemental, refined and quietly theatrical, created for gathering, ritual and hospitality.



Materiality

A layered composition shaped

The ritual within.

Rooted in the Irish tradition of the céilí, the Dún Briste Whiskey Bar is designed for welcome — a place to gather, to share a glass, a story and the company of others. In homes across Ireland, hospitality has long been shaped by music, folklore, poetry and conversation, with ritual and sociability woven naturally together.

Inspired by the Dún Briste sea stack, the bar brings the form, structure and layered materiality of the Irish landscape into the home. Stone, timber, linen, liquid metal and light come together in a composition that feels sculptural and ceremonial — contemporary in expression, yet deeply connected to tradition.

Like the spirit of the parting glass, it honours the moments that begin and end around hospitality: the welcome, the gathering, the shared pour and the lingering farewell.

Origin

Dún Briste, County Mayo

Named after the sea stack off the coast of County Mayo, the Dún Briste Whiskey Cabinet begins with place. The layered geology, dramatic cantilevers and sculptural silhouette of Dún Briste inspired a piece of furniture that feels both elemental and contemporary.

This cabinet evolved from the original Dún Briste Whiskey Bar. Its composition translates the Atlantic landscape into a collectible piece for the home — grounded, layered and quietly theatrical, with each shift in material echoing rock, earth, metal and light.



Materiality

A layered composition
shaped by land and memory.



- Liquid-metal cigar drawer — a warm sculptural layer referencing Ireland's Bronze Age.

- Bog oak barcode slatboard base — evokes the dark, furrowed land and the archaeology of bog oak.



- Integrated LED lighting — adds depth, ceremony and glow.
- Irish green marble interior — the living surface of the land brought inside.
- Brass framework and detailing — refined structure and subtle warmth.
- Cantilevered composition — echoes the projecting strata of Dún Bríste.

The ritual within.

Designed to be experienced with the doors open, the cabinet turns storage into ritual. Warm integrated lighting reveals a stepped display inspired by the Giant's Causeway, presenting each bottle with clarity and drama.

Below, the supporting cigar drawer keeps the accompaniments close at hand, creating a setting for conversation, hospitality and quiet ceremony.



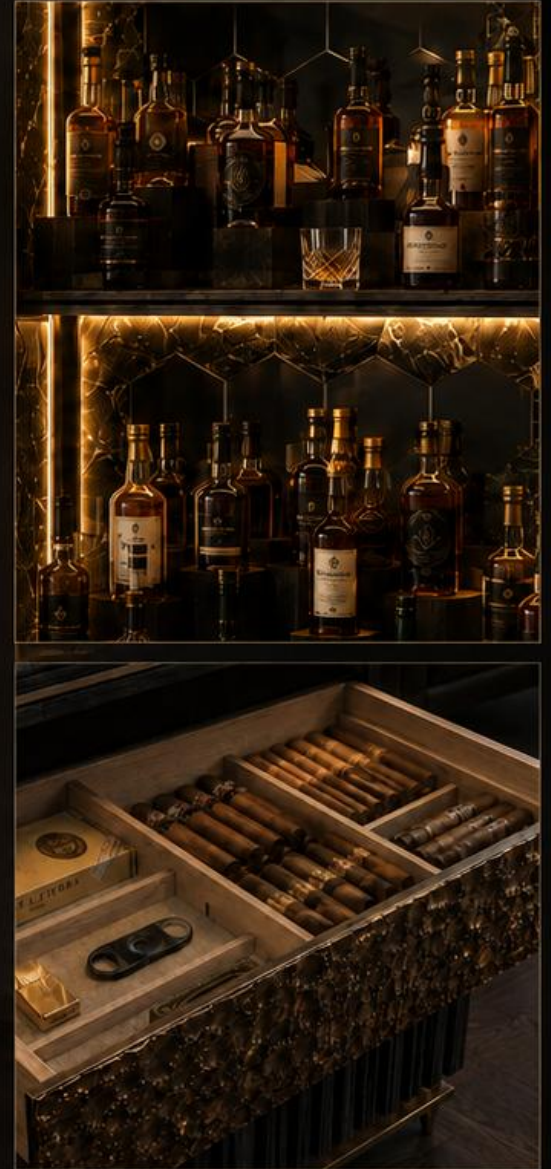

Origin

Dún Briste, County Mayo

Named after the iconic sea stack off the north Mayo coast, the Dún Briste Console begins with place. Its long horizon, grounded end supports and illuminated core translate the drama of Ireland's landscape into a calm, architectural form.

Stone, timber, bronze and light are brought together as a contemporary expression of Irish luxury — sculptural yet restrained, created for arrival, display and welcome, and deeply rooted in the atmosphere of land, memory and home.



Materiality

A layered composition shaped
by landscape, light and welcome.



The welcome within.

Created as a quiet moment of welcome, the Dún Briste Console brings atmosphere to the threshold and calm to the room. Light spills gently through the layered composition, turning arrival into ceremony.

The broad surface invites flowers, collected objects, books and letters, while the sculpted materials hold memory and presence. In the spirit of Irish hospitality, it is a piece for greeting, gathering and living beautifully.

Origin

Giant's Causeway, County Antrim

Named for the extraordinary basalt shoreline on Ireland's north coast, the Causeway Whiskey Cabinet begins with place. Its stepped forms, stratified textures and sculptural silhouette echo the rhythm of columnar stone, Atlantic weather and the drama of the Causeway landscape.

Created as a contemporary expression of Irish hospitality, it brings together bronze, charred timber, stone and light in a piece that feels elemental, ceremonial and quietly architectural — designed for gathering, conversation and the shared ritual of a poured glass.

Designed to be opened and experienced, the cabinet turns storage into ceremony. Warm integrated lighting reveals a stepped display inspired by the Giant's Causeway, presenting each bottle with clarity, depth and theatre.

Within, stone, timber and reflective surfaces create a setting for hospitality — a place for the shared pour, the passing of stories and the rhythms of music, conversation and welcome that have long shaped Irish life.

A lower serving drawer keeps the accompaniments close at hand, bringing ritual and practicality together in one sculptural piece.

Origin

Giant's Causeway, County Antrim

Born from one of Ireland's most elemental landscapes, the Causeway Console Table takes its inspiration from the distinctive basalt columns that rise from the Atlantic edge.

Rather than reproducing the landscape literally, the design captures its rhythm — the changing height, irregular formation and sense of the land emerging from the sea.

Black Irish oak columns rise from a reflective plane, carrying the movement of the Causeway upward through the furniture and onto its surface.

Born of the land. Created for contemporary living.



Materiality

A composition of Irish material, craft and landscape.



Black Irish oak
Sculptural hexagonal columns translating the rhythm of the Causeway into solid timber.

Artisan antique mirror glass
Handcrafted in Ireland, its shifting blue surface evokes the movement and reflection of the Atlantic.



Irish green marble
A refined natural surface crowning the composition.

Irish bleached ash
Light, tactile timber forming the architectural drawer structure.

Irish linen
Upholstered drawer fronts bringing softness and texture to the piece.

Integrated warm light
Concealed beneath the drawer composition, illuminating the columns and emphasising their changing height and form.

The form within.

At the heart of the Causeway Console Table is a landscape expressed in three dimensions.

Hexagonal columns rise at varying heights from the mirrored surface below, creating an undulating formation inspired by the rugged geometry of Ireland's northern coast.

Their movement appears to continue through the drawer composition before emerging again across the marble surface — an expression of the natural force from which the landscape was formed.

Warm concealed light falls across the black Irish oak, revealing changes in height, shadow and texture.

Above, functional drawers combine bleached Irish ash, upholstered Irish linen and precise black-oak detailing — bringing craftsmanship and utility into the sculptural composition.

Origin

Giant's Causeway, County Antrim

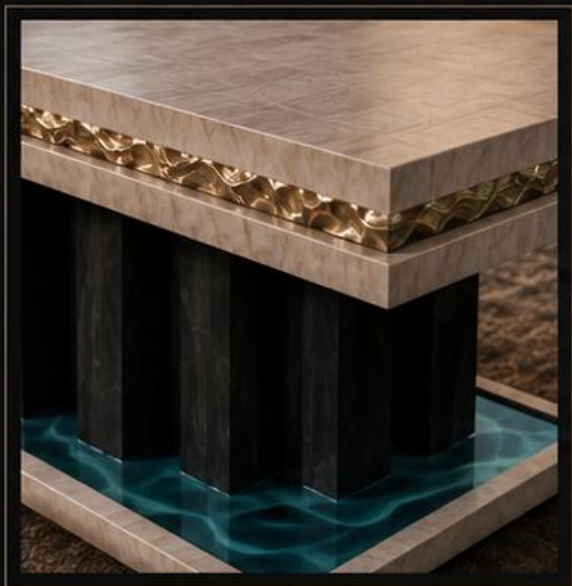
Named after the basalt wonder of County Antrim, the Causeway Coffee Table begins with the ground beneath our feet. Its rising hexagonal forms echo the geology of the north coast, while the cantilevered composition captures the tension between balance, force and erosion.

Blue antique mirror glass suggests the Atlantic sea, from which black Irish oak basalt columns appear to rise. Bleached ash, hammered bronze liquid metal and sculptural form translate Ireland's rugged edge into a contemporary centrepiece for extraordinary interiors.

The centre of the room.

Designed as a sculptural centrepiece, the Causeway Coffee Table gives the room a point around which life naturally gathers. Its rising basalt forms, pale ash surfaces, bronze detailing and mirrored plinth make the landscape tangible within the home.

Balancing function with artistry, it becomes a place for conversation, hospitality and pause — a contemporary statement piece shaped by Irish land, material memory and the skill of artisan makers.

From the sea-suggesting blue mirror glass below to the basalt forms emerging through the top, every layer speaks of origin translated into modern living.





Made to belong.

From coastal modern interiors to city penthouses and grounded Irish settings, the Causeway collection adapts with ease while remaining unmistakably sculptural.

The rectangular cantilevered table leads the collection, while a circular interpretation offers an alternative expression of the same material story — basalt, sea, bronze, ash and mirror brought into the centre of the room.

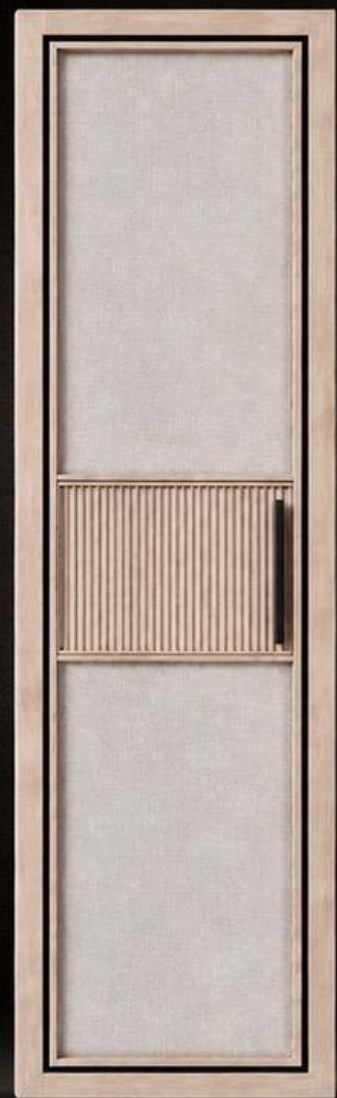
