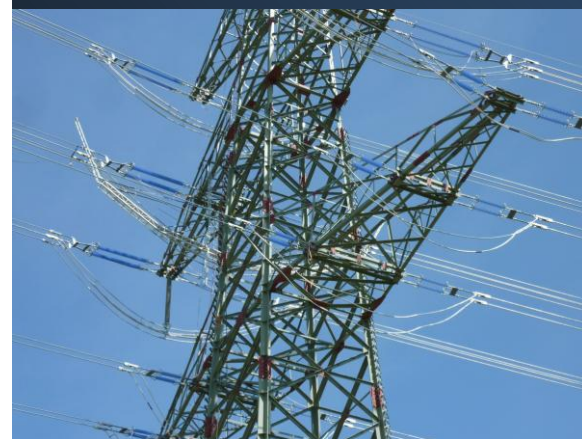

The Critical Infrastructure Landscape Has Changed

- 30% surge in cyber attacks on critical infrastructure globally (2023-2024)
- Slovakia experienced unprecedented cyberattacks in early 2025
- New Law 367/2024 on Critical Infrastructure effective January 1, 2025
- 11 critical sectors and 23 subsectors under enhanced regulatory supervision by 10 public authorities
- 78 fundamental services ensuring vital societal functions or key economic activities
- Geopolitical instability creating new security challenges
