The Critical Infrastructure Landscape Has Changed

- 30% surge in cyber attacks on critical infrastructure globally (2023-2024)
- Slovakia experienced unprecedented cyberattacks in early 2025
- New Law 367/2024 on Critical Infrastructure effective January 1, 2025
- 11 critical sectors now under enhanced regulatory oversight
- 79 fundamental services ensuring vital societal functions or key economic activities
- Geopolitical instability creating new security challenges





Regulatory Compliance: Critical Deadlines Approaching



Law 367/2024 implements EU CER Directive 2022/2557 Risk assessment submission deadline: August 31, 2025

Strategy development deadline:

October 31, 2025

Critical entity identification:

July 17, 2026



Penalties up to €500,000 for noncompliance Slovakia among first EU members to transpose CER directive



Spain's 24-hour nationwide power grid failure (2024)


Slovakia's cadastral office cyberattack paralyzed real estate market


