

## RECYCLING INFORMATION

## ONLY USE RECYCLE BINS DO NOT PUT RECYCLE MATERIALS IN PLASTIC BAGS OR GARBAGE CANS

Each residence has been provided a container for recyclable materials. Contact the township office, 586-725-0263, if your container has been damaged

## **ITEMS ACCEPTED:**

News paper, plastic food/soap containers (#'s 1-8), tin and aluminum cans, glass food jars (any color), paper board (i.e. cereal boxes, Kleenex boxes etc.), cardboard (not wax coated) cut to 2'x 2' and bundled, magazines, phone books, junk mail, flyers, office paper, shredded paper and beverage bottles

## **NOT ACCEPTED:**

Plastic bags, styrofoam, packing peanuts, plastic flats from flowers and vegetables, flower pots, chemical or petroleum containers, aerosol cans, food container not emptied or rinsed out, wax coated cardboard, medical waste (including needles and syringes), hoses, straw, glassware, cookware, light bulbs, building materials, nails, nuts & bolts, small appliances, glass block, window glass, wire, electronics etc.
