These beautiful, patriotic banners will be displayed county-wide yearly for one week prior to and one week after Memorial Day.

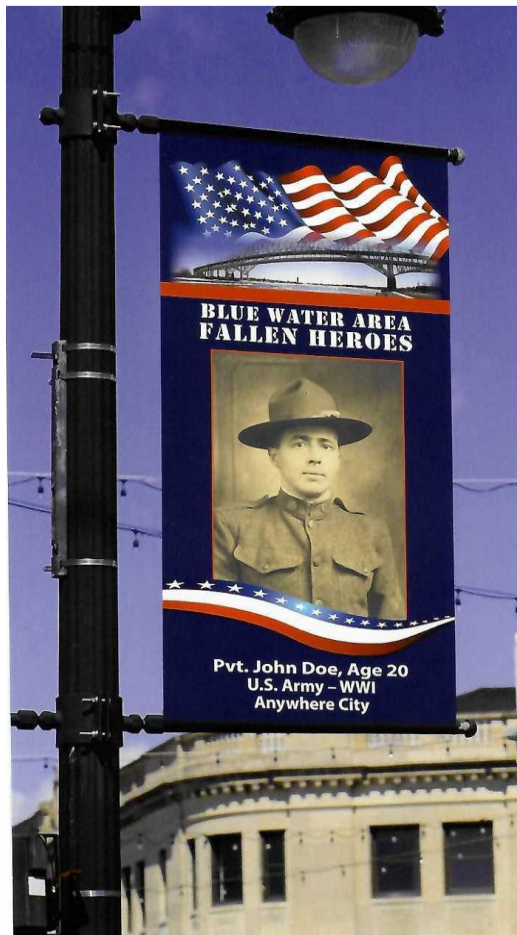
