Notice is hereby given that the State Primary Election will be held for the qualified electors of the Township of Ira on Tuesday, **August 4, 2026** from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m., at the Township Hall, 7085 Meldrum Road, Fair Haven, MI 48023.

PUBLIC ACCURACY TEST

The public accuracy test of the tabulation voting equipment is scheduled for **11:30 a.m. on July 7, 2026** at the Office of the Township Clerk. The public test will be conducted for the purpose of testing the accuracy of the tabulating equipment and programs, which will be used to tabulate the voted ballots. The Public is invited to attend.

EARLY VOTING

The Township will offer early voting for nine (9) consecutive designated days prior to the election beginning **July 25, 2026 and ending on August 2, 2026 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day.** Ballots cast during early voting will not be tabulated until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day and the tabulation of votes will take place at the Township Hall.

SATURDAY CLERK'S OFFICE HOURS

The Township Clerk's office will be open Saturday, **August 1, 2026** from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., for electors who wish to receive an absent voter ballot for the election.

ABSENT VOTER BALLOTS

Absent voter ballots for the Election will be available at the Office of the Township Clerk, 7085 Meldrum Road, Fair Haven, MI 48023, Monday through Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., until **August 3, 2026 at 4:00 p.m.** Electors who have lost their absentee ballot or not yet received their ballot in the mail may submit a written request to spoil their absent voter ballot and receive a new absent voter ballot in the clerk's office until **August 3, 2026 at 4:00 p.m.**
