MINUTES (UNAPPROVED)

The Board of Supervisors met in a special session on June 4, 2026, at 3:00 p.m., at Welcome Center, 335 Sioux Point Road, Dakota Dunes. Members present were: Messrs. Beaulieu, Shorma, and Ms. Finzen. Members absent were: Messrs. Wetz and Hanson. Employees present were: Andrew Tramp and Katelyn Irby. Public present were: Vonda Brandshaw, Wayne Bradshaw, Susan Allison, and Boyd Allison, Dakota Dunes residents.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting was called to order by Mr. Beaulieu.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mr. Beaulieu led the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

A motion was made by Ms. Finzen and seconded by Mr. Shorma to approve the agenda.

Motion passed 3-0.

4. CONFLICTS OF INTEREST DISCLOSURE

No conflicts of interest were presented.

5. PUBLIC COMMENT

Wayne Bradshaw asked about upcoming vacancies on the Dakota Dunes CID Board and how an unexpired term would be filled. The Board of Supervisors and Mr. Tramp explained that current board member terms are posted on the Dakota Dunes website. They also explained that, under South Dakota law, if a vacancy occurs during a term, the remaining board members appoint someone to serve the rest of the unexpired term. Mr. Tramp explained that in the past the CID has posted a notice of vacancy due to a resignation in the newspaper and accepted letters of interest. The CID Board then gathers all letters received and appoints someone from the letters of interest to fulfill the unexpired term.

Boyd Allison expressed concerns about board seat appointments and the short notice for posted meeting agendas. Mr. Tramp explained that, under South Dakota law, the CID must post the agenda within 24 hours of a meeting. Agendas are posted on the doors of the Welcome Center, which serves as the CID office and meeting location, and on the Dakota Dunes website.

5. PUBLIC COMMENT (CONTINUED)

Mr. Bradshaw also asked for an update on the official opinion from the South Dakota Attorney General's Office regarding the legality of golf carts on the Boulevard. Mr. Shorma and Mr. Tramp reported that a formal opinion has been requested and that we are awaiting a response.

6. NEW BUSINESS

Following the review of the official election information, including the returns from each precinct and the total number of votes received for each candidate, a motion was made by Ms. Finzen and seconded by Mr. Shorma to accept the following as the official election results for the Dakota Dunes Community Improvement District Board of Supervisor's election.

Brian Goeden, with 348 votes

Scott Wetz, with 271 votes

Total number of votes cast was 619

Elected to the six-year term is: Brian Goeden
