Arlette's Journey:

1. Born, 1938 in Paris, France
2. Family arrested in 1942 by two Nazi soldiers
 1. Her father bribed the officers to spare Arlette
3. Arlette was sent by her maid to live with her Catholic grandmother in Paris and her parents were taken to a concentration camp in Drancy, Paris
4. Then her parents were deported to Auschwitz, Poland and were put to death in February, 1943
5. After Paris was liberated Arlette lived with her grandparents in Paris
6. Later she traveled to the US to marry her late husband and enroll in NYU and Mt. Saint Vincent. She later taught Latin and French.
