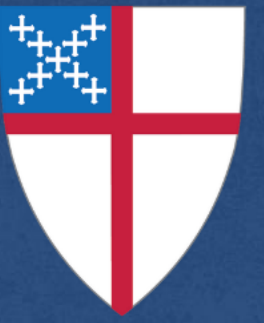




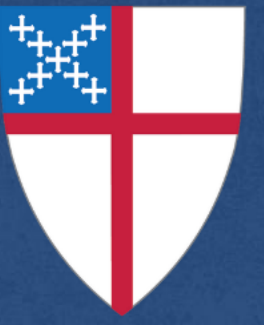

The sure prophetic word.



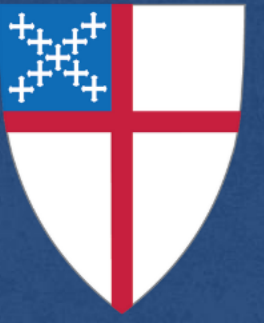

from the prison those who sit in darkness.

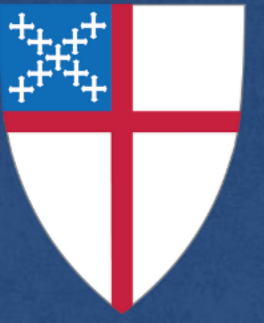

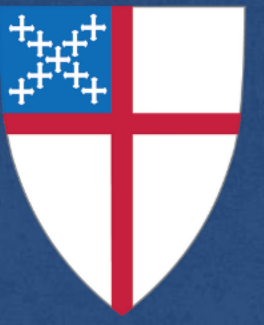

Second Reading

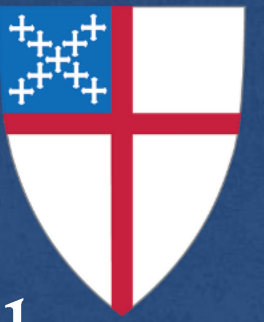
Acts 10:34–43

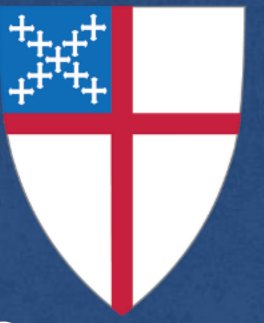


The Candidate for Holy Baptism

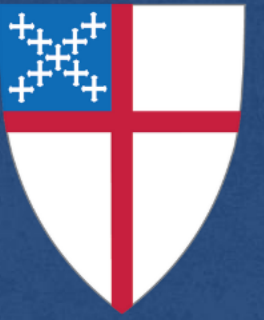

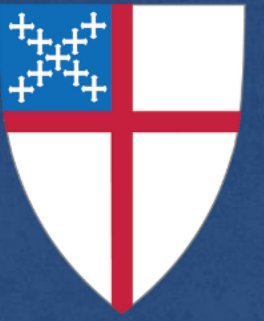

Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary.



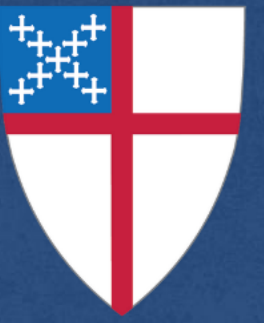

I will, with God's help.



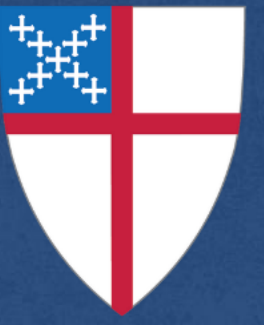

and ever.

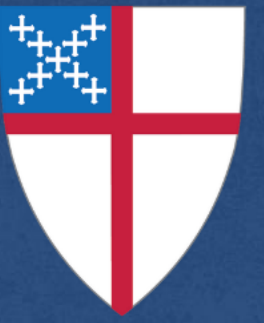

Jesus our Lord.*

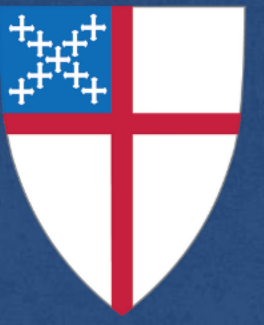
