

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

In light of the tragic shooting at Annunciation Catholic School on August 27, we have made the following decisions:

- 1. Our weekday parish Masses will be Tuesday-Friday at 8:00 AM throughout the year.
- 2. For the safety and security of St. Pascal Regional Catholic School students and staff, School Masses are closed to the public.

Please keep the families and community of Annunciation Catholic Parish and School in your prayers.

Statement from Archbishop Hebda (August 27, 2025)

"I am so grateful for the many promises of prayers that have been coming in from the Holy Father, Pope Leo, and from so many from all around the globe, all praying for the families of Annunciation Parish and School and for all who were impacted by this morning's senseless violence. I beg for the continued prayers of all of the priests and faithful of this Archdiocese, as well for the prayers of all men and women of good will, that the healing that only God can bring will be poured out on all those who were present at this morning's Mass and particularly for the affected families who are only now beginning to comprehend the trauma they sustained. We lift up the souls of those who lost their lives to our loving God through the intercession of Our Lady, Queen of Peace. My heart is broken as I think about students, teachers, clergy and parishioners and the horror they witnessed in a Church, a place where we should feel safe. That today's tragedy occurred only a day after the tragic shooting near Cristo Rey High School increases the sadness about the pain and anger that is present in our communities. We need an end to gun violence. Our community is rightfully outraged at such horrific acts of violence perpetrated against the vulnerable and innocent. They are far too commonplace. While we need to commit to working to prevent the recurrence of such tragedies, we also need to remind ourselves that we have a God of peace and of love, and that it is his love that we will need most as we strive to embrace those who are hurting so deeply. Members of the Archdiocesan staff are working with the parish and school teams to make sure they have the support and resources they need at this time and beyond. Our Lady, Queen of Sorrows, pray for us."

Prayer Intention of Pope Leo XIV for September 2025: For our relationship with all of creation. Let us pray that, inspired by Saint Francis, we might experience our interdependence with all creatures who are loved by God and worthy of love and respect.
