

#### **We Care Campaign**

# **Option 1: Cross Catholic Outreach** *Building Homes in Guatemala*

Cross Catholic Outreach partners with local Catholic leaders and organizations to provide durable homes for impoverished families in rural Guatemala.

# **Option 2: Next Step Program**

A Hennepin Healthcare hospital-based intervention program, Next Step connects survivors of violent injury to resources and support. While in the hospital, patients are provided with assistance. Once released, they are assigned to case managers who help them change their lives and stop the cycle of violence.

If you prefer to give to one or more of these charities, please indicate this on the envelope and your contributions will be distributed as requested.
