CONFIRMATION CODE OF CONDUCT January 2026-April 2027

I will promote the St. Pascal Confirmation Candidate Community based on mutual respect and a sense of personal well being. I have read the following rules, designed to promote the well-being, health and safety of all Confirmation participants, and have indicated my unqualified acceptance by my signature and that of my parent/guardian. If any of these rules are broken at any time during the Confirmation sessions or retreats, my parent/guardian is responsible to immediately retrieve me and incur any expenses.

- 1. I will not possess, consume, or by a physician. If any tobacco products, drugs, alcohol, or paraphernalia are found in my possession, they will be confiscated and not returned, and immediate action will be taken. distribute alcoholic beverages. Nor will I possess, use or distribute any tobacco product (including cigarettes), drugs or drug paraphernalia, with the sole exception of using medication as prescribed for me
- 2. I agree to refrain from engaging in sexual behavior with other persons, which includes physical contact such as kissing, etc.
- 3. I will not commit any illegal act. I understand that vandalism, disturbing the peace, or other inappropriate behavior as determined by the adult leadership will not be tolerated. I understand that I will have to pay for any damage that I cause. I understand that no gambling is allowed.
- 4. **Any** electronic device (cell phones, iPODs, and the like) in my possession will be in the **OFF** position at all times during the confirmation sessions. Any found being on and used will be confiscated until the end of the session.
- 5. I will not bring any weapons. If found in my possession they will be confiscated and immediate appropriate action will be taken.
- 6. I understand that for the protection and safety of all participants, acts of violence or harassment will not be tolerated. Violence and harassment include fighting, physical or verbal assault or abuse, ethnic insults, name-calling, bullying, teasing, profane or obscene language, gestures, or actions.
- 7. I will refrain from any self-destructive behavior (that threatens one's own physical or psychological health).
- 8. I understand that if I see or learn of a fellow participant engaging in behavior that is a threat to his or her safety, or the safety of others, during the Confirmation sessions or retreat, I must immediately notify an adult leader.
- 9. I will attend and participate fully in the Confirmation sessions and retreats.

- 10. I will treat fellow participants, leadership, retreat staff, and myself in a respectful manner.
- 11. I will remain at the Confirmation sessions or retreats in the assigned places at all times.
- 12. I understand that no unauthorized guests are allowed at any sessions or the retreats, and that any unauthorized guests will be asked to leave immediately.
- 13. I agree to abide by any additional rules, pertinent to specific sessions, which may be announced, and to accept the consequences of their violation.

I UNDERSTAND THAT THESE RULES OF BEHAVIOR APPLY FROM THE TIME I LEAVE HOME FOR A SESSION/RETREAT, DURING THE SESSION/RETREAT ITSELF, AND UNTIL I RETURN HOME AFTER THE SESSION/RETREAT.

THESE RULES ARE IN EFFECT FOR ALL SESSIONS/RETREATS FROM JANUARY 4, 2026 THROUGH THE FINAL CONFIRMATION SESSION IN 2027.
