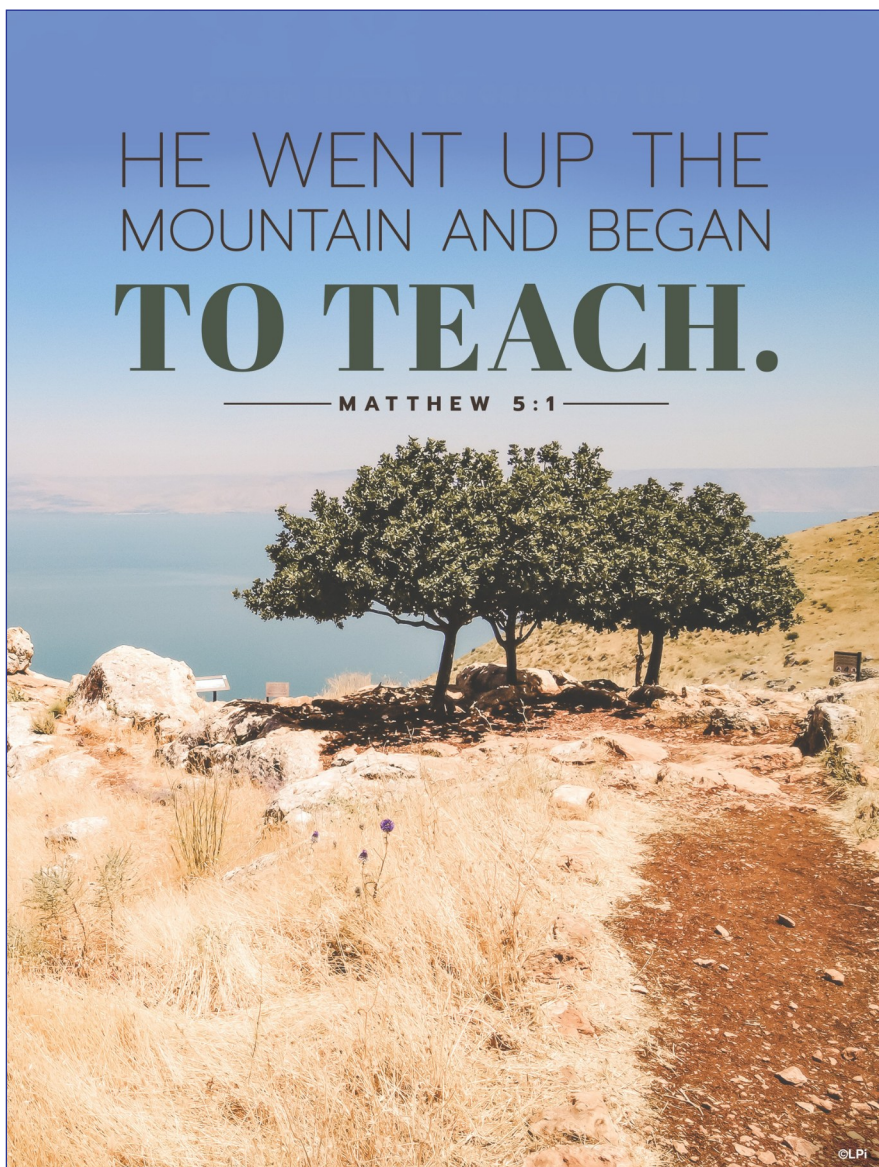

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

Statement Regarding the Death of Alex Pretti and Invitation to Prayer:

January 25, 2026, from Archbishop Bernard A. Hebda

Following Saturday's tragic shooting in Minneapolis, I ask all people of good will to join me today in prayer for Alex Jeffrey Pretti, for his parents, and for his loved ones. The loss of another life amidst the tensions that have gripped Minnesota should prompt all of us to ask what we can do to restore the Lord's peace. While we rightly thirst for God's justice and hunger for his peace, this will not be achieved until we are able to rid our hearts of the hatreds and prejudices that prevent us from seeing each other as brothers and sisters created in the image and likeness of God. That is as true for our undocumented neighbors as it is for our elected officials and for the men and women who have the unenviable responsibility of enforcing our laws. They all need our humble prayers.

The 2026 Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) has begun. With roots going back to 1959, the annual Catholic Services Appeal is our response as a Catholic community to the day-to-day needs of the many important ministries of the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis, namely: Catholic Elementary and High School Scholarships, Drexel Mission School Support, College Campus Ministry, Seminarian Support, Shelter & Food Insecurity programs, Hospital Ministry, Prison Ministry, Respect Life Outreach, Life Fund Emergency Services, Marriage, Family and Youth Programs, Latino Ministry, Indian Ministry, Deaf Ministry, and the Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women. If you gave to the CSA last year, you should receive a letter from the Appeal Office inviting you to make a gift for 2026. You can also give online by scanning this QR code:

Good news: in 2025, we received a grant of \$ 3,998.00 from the Catholic Services Appeal to support the American Sign Language ministry here at our parish. These funds help pay the stipends for our ASL interpreters at the 10:30 AM Sunday Mass. Our 2026 CSA goal for St. Pascals is \$40,930. This number is calculated by multiplying 5% by our 2025 Sunday donations from the plate and envelopes. In 2025, our CSA goal was \$40,274, and St. Pascal's parishioners contributed \$23,616 toward it. *Thank you for your support and prayers for the Catholic Services Appeal.*
