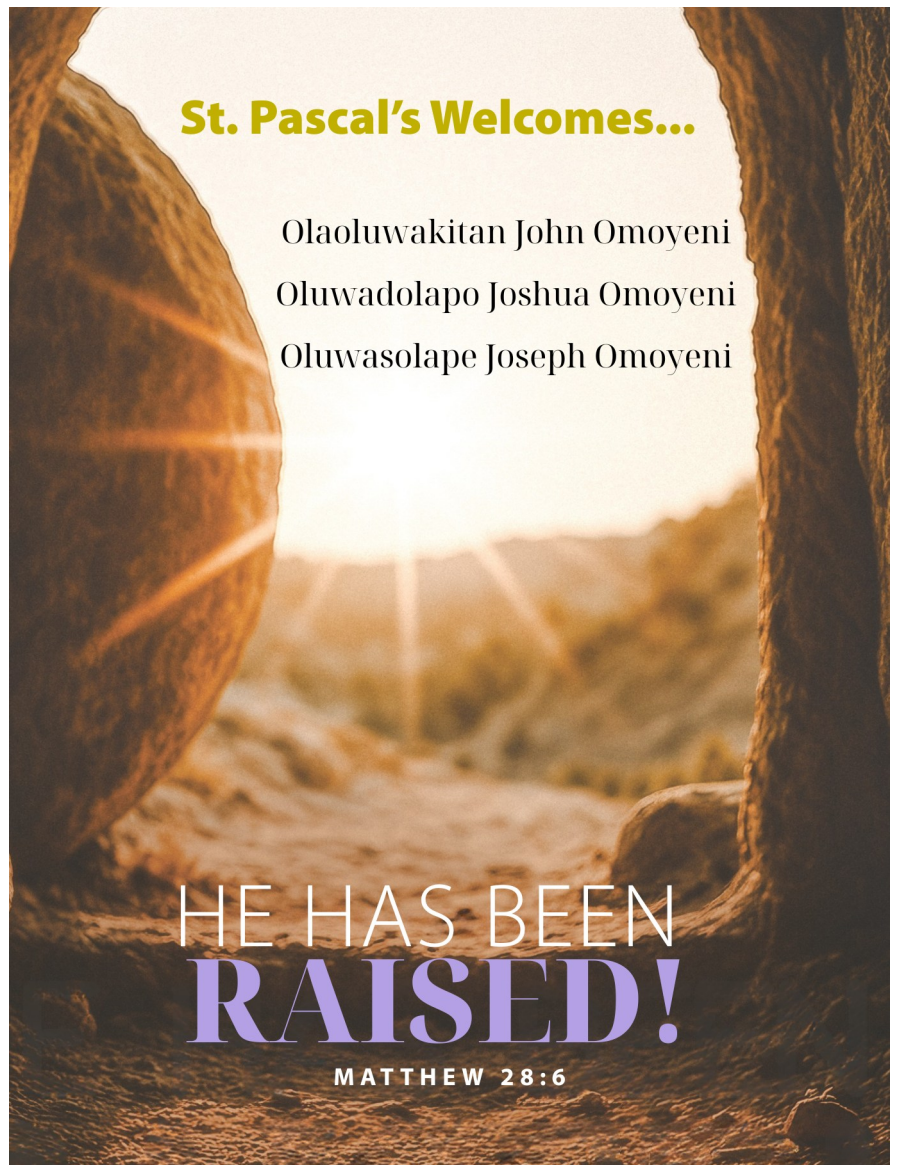

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

Happy Easter! From all of us here at St. Pascal Baylon Church, we wish you and your family a joyful Easter. Last year during his 2025 Easter Sunday homily, Pope Leo XIV urged Christians to actively seek the Risen Jesus in their daily lives. The Pope said, “We must look for him without ceasing. Because if Jesus has risen from the dead, then he is present everywhere, he dwells among us, he hides himself and reveals himself even today in the sisters and brothers we meet along the way. The protagonists of the Easter narratives all ran! This ‘running’ expresses, on the one hand, the concern that the Lord’s body had been taken away; but, on the other hand, the running of Mary Magdalene, Peter and John expresses the desire, the yearning of the heart, the inner attitude of those who set out to search for Jesus.” Let us run to meet the Lord today and ask him to strengthen the gift of faith we have received.

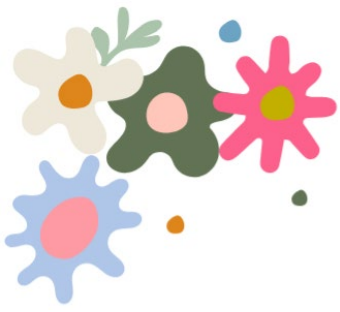
Annual Author's Night: Monday, April 13 in Brioschi Hall St. Pascal's Women's Book Club

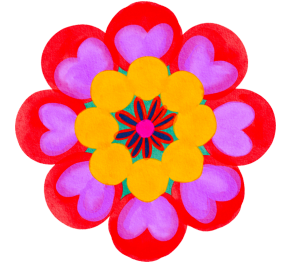
