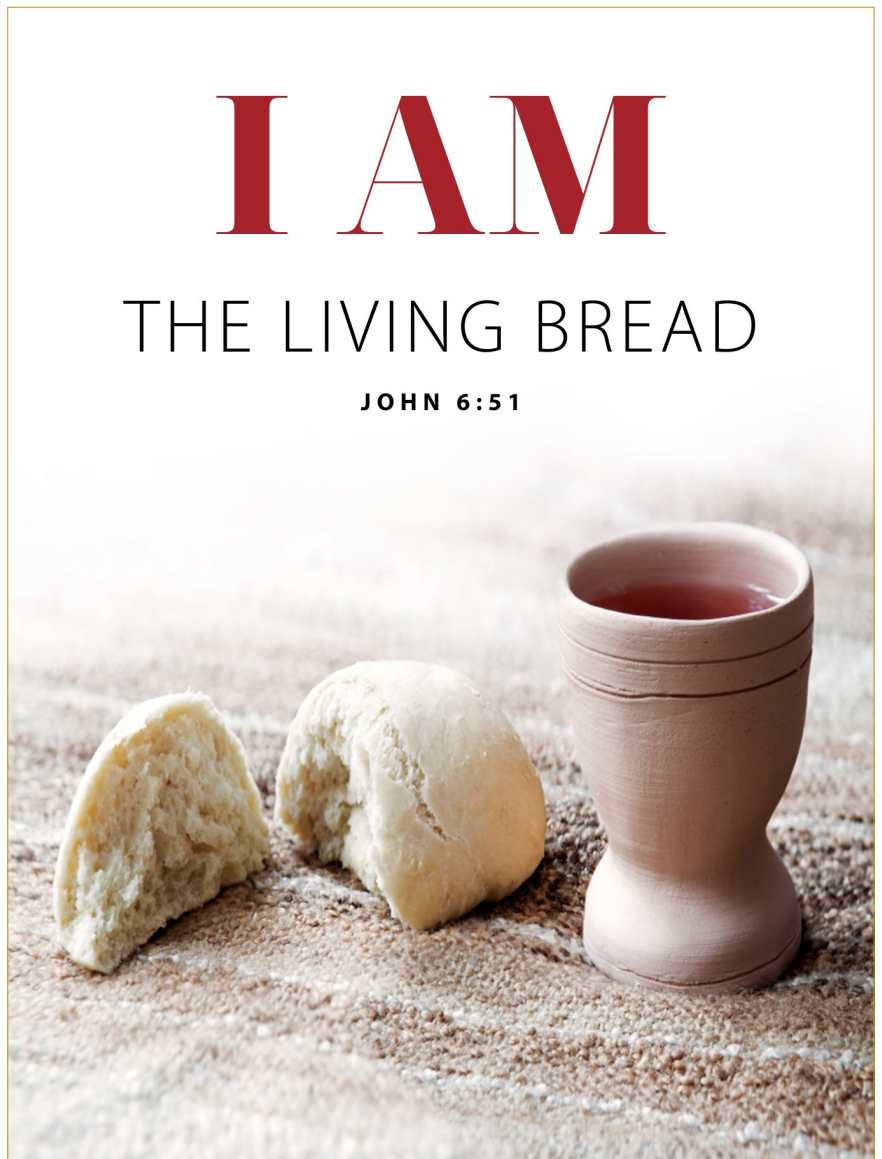

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

We welcome Emily Cicha to St. Pascal Baylon Parish as our new Pastoral Associate for Music. Emily's first official day of ministry at our parish was June 1. She spent some hours working here in May and meeting with Sharon Balcom, who retired after 23 years as our Pastoral Associate for Music. Emily has worked as a high school and middle school choir director. She has a Bachelor of Science Degree in music education from the University of Mary in Bismarck, North Dakota. Please join me in welcoming Emily to our parish.

Financial update. During the months of April and May, we have seen our Sunday collections decrease by 35%. There may be more than one reason for this decrease. I know the past couple of years have seen increases in grocery costs, rent costs and other day-to-day expenses. The increase in gasoline prices over the past two months may have been an additional factor in our Sunday collections declining in April and May. On the positive side, we are a blessed parish community. I see your generosity each month in feeding our hungry neighbors through our Merrick Food distribution, you helped during January and February with financial support for food and rent costs for our brothers and sisters at Sacred Heart parish, you supported our 2026 Fund-A-Need project for plumbing upgrades in the school, and our overall parish income for the past 9 months was solid and on budget. If possible, please remember our parish in the Sunday collections during June. Every little bit helps. Thank you.

Parish Lending Library. I invite you to browse the parish book collection on the bookshelves in the Gathering Space. The procedures to "check out" and "return" materials are posted on the library's bookshelves. The collection includes more than 200 titles for children, teens, and adults. We also have a handful of DVD movies depicting various saints in the Church and other theological topics.
