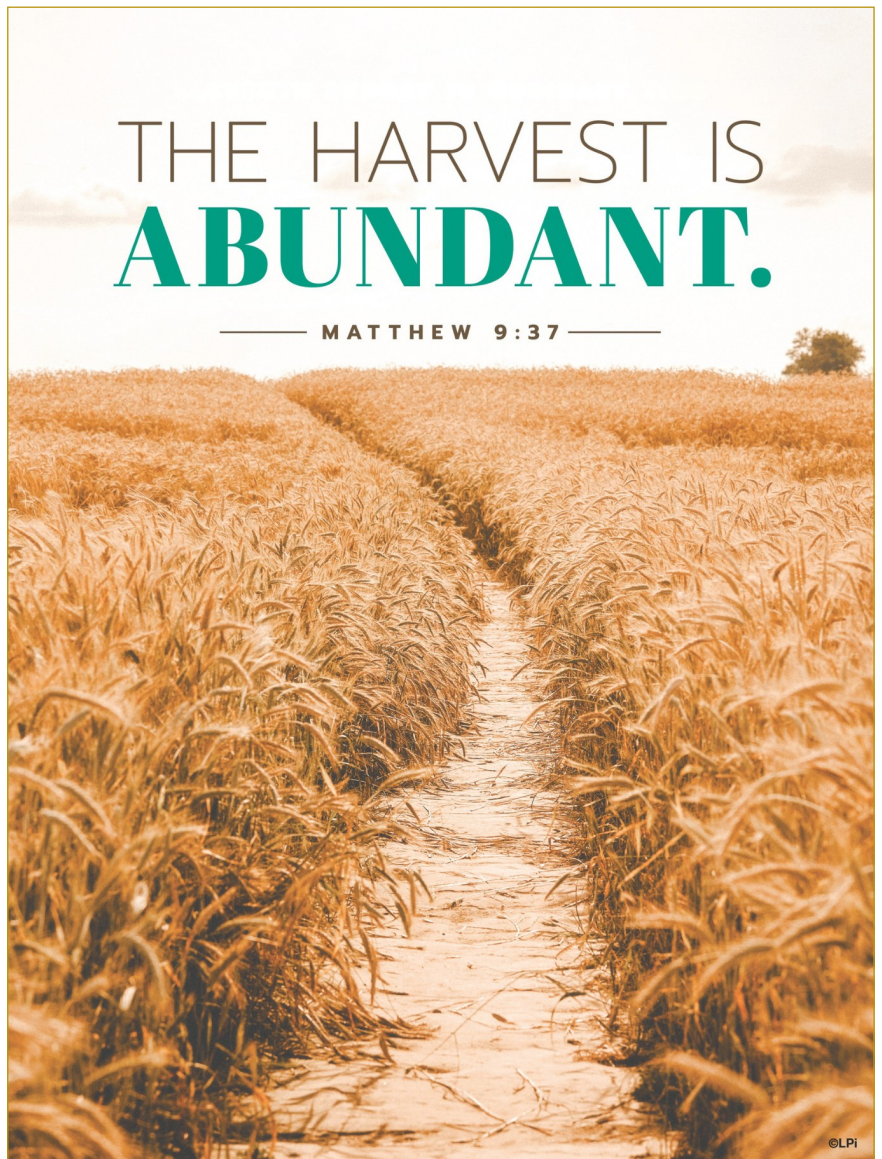

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

**Mission Appeal weekend.** This weekend, we will welcome Sister Leticia Villegas from the Dominican Sisters of the Christian Doctrine. She will share a message at all Masses as part of the Missionary Cooperative Plan (MCP) of the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. The MCP gives us an opportunity to stand in solidarity with the global mission of the Church by hearing and responding to a Catholic missionary group. The Dominican Sisters of the Christian Doctrine serve in countries such as Equatorial Guinea and Mexico. The Sisters bring education, Catholic faith formation, meals, and health care to children and families in the villages where they serve. In Ciudad Juárez, Mexico, the Sisters offer daycare, healthy meals, preschool, and religious formation to 65 children living in a city with high rates of poverty and violence. The Sisters also offer faith formation to parents so that the education the students receive at school has continuity at home. There will be a second collection at Mass this weekend to help the ministry of the Sisters.
